ADB President praises govt for achievement in food sector

The visiting ADB President, Kinimasa Tarumizu, yesterday highly appraised the present government for achieving a near self-sufficiency in food, reports BSS.

The ADB President said this while meeting with Agriculture and Irrigation, Water Development and Flood Control Minister Major General (Retd) M Majid-ul-Haq at his office here yesterday. Tarumizu said that agriculture, is the main driving force of the economy of Bangladesh. He congratulated the government for keeping proper attention and achieving more and more success in this sector. He wanted to know the process of implementation of crop diversification programmes in Bangladesh. The Agriculture Minister informed the ADB president that Bangladesh had taken positive steps to increase production of pulses, oil seeds, wheat and maize. He said agriculture extension department had established demonstration plots of sunflower to motivate the farmers. Tarumizu also inquired about the activities of IADC. The minister informed him that necessary steps were under way to reduce the size of IADC. He said that it would exist on a small scale to face any crisis situation. The ADB president expressed his deep concern to know the present condition of water flow in various rivers of Bangladesh. Gen. Majid-ul-Haq informed him that due to Farakka barrage, the GK project of Bangladesh was now closed and as a result, a lot of agriculture lands would not get irrigation facilities in the south-west region of the country. The ADB President gave assurance that the ADB would provide all possible help to complete the FAP (Flood Action Plan) study of Bangladesh. Agriculture Secretary A N M Yusuf and Irrigation Secretary M Asafud-doula were present in the meeting.

Khaleda condoles Nuruzzaman's death

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia yesterday condoled the death of Brigadier (Retd) ANM Nuruzzaman, Bir Uttam, Bangladesh Ambassador to Sweden, reports BSS.

Begum Zia recalled the contribution of Brigadier Nuruzzaman in the War of Independence. She expressed sympathy to the members of the bereaved family and prayed for the peace of the departed soul.

Brigadier Nuruzzaman died in Stockholm on March 16 last.

Zillur Awami League General Secretary Zillur Rahman yesterday expressed shock at the death of Bangladesh High Commissioner to Sweden Brig (Retd) ANM Nuruzzaman. Nuruzzaman was one of the Sector Commanders during the country's War of Liberation in 1971.

Prof M Shamsheer Ali made fellow of TWAS

Prof M Shamsheer Ali, Vice-Chancellor of Bangladesh Open University has been elected a fellow of the Third World Academy of Science (TWAS), headquartered at Trieste, Italy and chaired by Noble Laureate Prof. Abdus Salam, says a press release.

This election of fellowship is made by a world body of distinguished scientists and constitutes one of the highest recognitions of international scientific contributions.

Prof Shamsheer Ali, a renowned nuclear physicist, had earlier been a corresponding fellow of the Academy and had been given a special award by TWASO (Third World Network of Scientific Organization), an organ of the Third World Academy of Science, for promotion of the public understanding of science. Prof. Ali who is a Senior Associate of the International Centre for Theoretical Physics (ICTP) has also made outstanding contribution to science and development issues. He is also a fellow and council member of the Islamic Academy of Science, Jordan.

BSS adds: Dr AM Harun-ar-Rashid, Professor of the Department of Physics, Dhaka University, has been elected fellow of the Third World Academy of Science, a university press release said yesterday.

This was decided by the Council of the Academy in a meeting held recently in Kuwait. The President of the Academy Nobel laureate Professor Abdus Salam has sent a letter conveying this message to Professor Harun-ar-Rashid and congratulated him.
