Two killed in road mishap in Khulna

KHULNA, Mar 30: Two youngmen were killed when a minibus knocked a motor cycle near Ilalpur Ansar Camp in Rupsa thana on Khulna-Mongla road on Monday, reports UNB.

The dead were identified as Siraj (30) and Rokon (28) of village Chulakathi in Bagerhat district, who were riding on the motor cycle.

Witnesses said the accident occurred as the motor cycle tried to overtake the Rupsa-bound minibus coming from Mongla hat. Siraj died on the spot and Rokon succumbed to his injury at Khulna Sadar hospital.

Police seized the bus but its driver and helper managed to escape.

A case was filed with Rupsa thana in this connection.

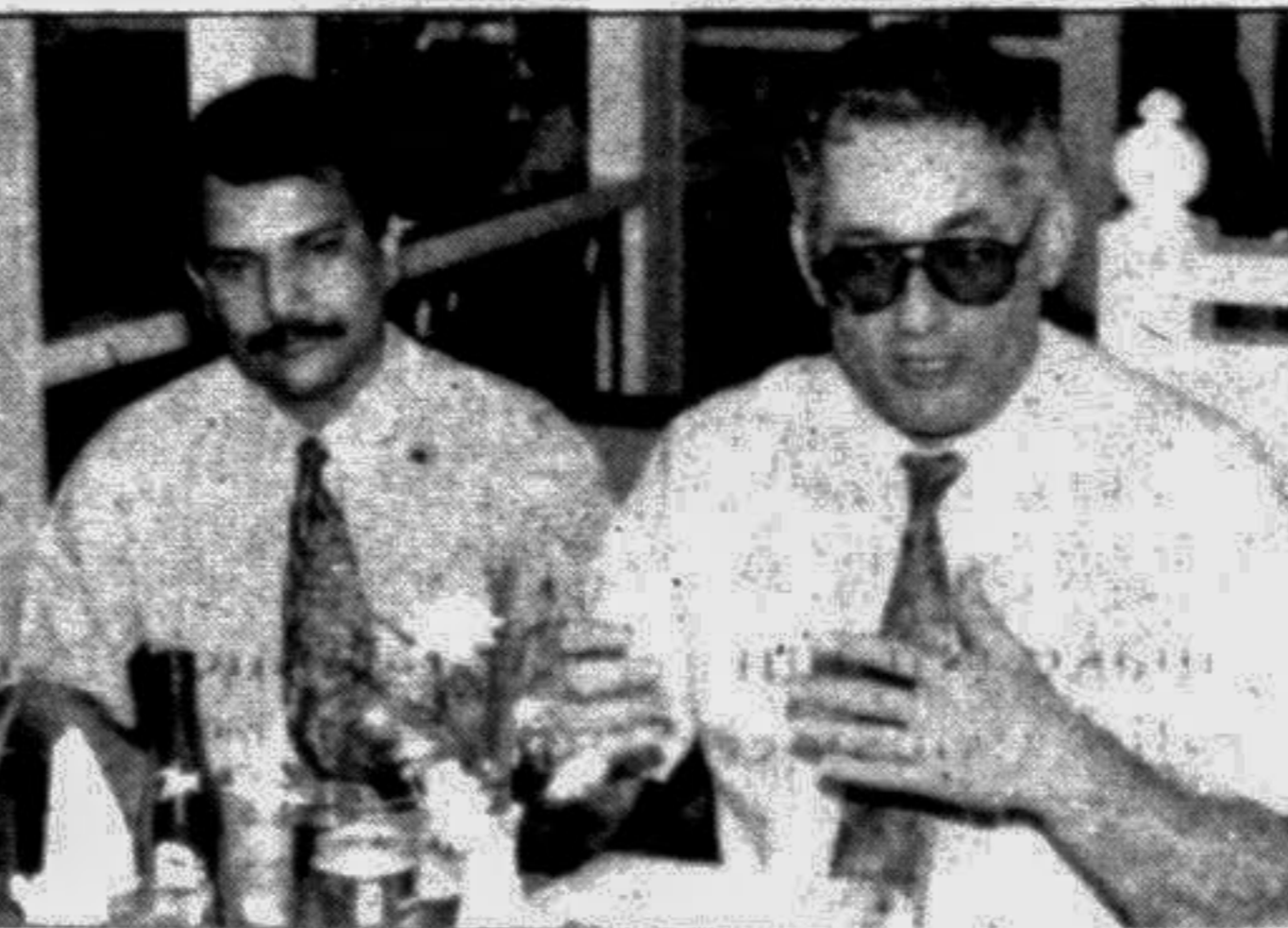

BA World Cargo offers more space

British Airways World Cargo will offer more space to Bangladesh cargo, said Keith Gascoigne, Regional Cargo Manager for South of the airlines.

Talking to newsmen Tuesday, Gascoigne said that the airlines' newly-introduced world cargo service will help to increase Bangladesh's export, especially garments.

Gascoigne is now in the city in connection with the launching of British Airways World Cargo Service in Bangladesh. The Service begins Friday along with the introduction of British Airways (BA) fourth weekly flight on Dhaka-London route via Bombay.

Expressing satisfaction with the growing business of British Airways in Bangladesh, Gascoigne said that the airline has been carrying about 270 tons cargo from Dhaka including transshipment through other airlines. With the introduction of fourth weekly flight from Dhaka, the volume of export will go up to 300 tons.

During 1991-92, British Airways carried Bangladeshi cargo worth 3.5 million pound sterling while the projection for the current fiscal year is four million. 90 per cent of these cargo is ready-made garments most of which destined to United States.

Gascoigne told newsmen that the expansion of cargo service will enable British Airways to offer more space to Bangladeshi exporters on its direct flights to Bombay and onward to any other destination.

This will also help the country's importers, particularly in the textile sector, who will have more space ready to import raw materials. He said that British Airways World Cargo was the first carrier in Bangladesh to offer the Garments on Hanger (GOH) containers facility enabling Bangladeshi manufacturers to export high fashion clothing to world markets faster.

MS Shaheque, Manager of the British Airways World Cargo in Bangladesh was also present.
