

# Workshop on family planning begins

A standing committee was also formed in this regard, the press release said.

# Disaster Management Bureau formed

Government has set up a new organization 'Disaster Management Bureau' under the Ministry of Relief to gear up the disaster management in the country, reports UNB.

Headed by a Director-General, the Bureau will begin its activities soon.

It was disclosed yesterday at a review meeting of the Ministry of Relief, held at its conference room with State Minister for Relief Lutfur Rahman Khan in the chair.

The new Bureau will play a vital role to strengthen and gear up the disaster management during pre and post disaster as well as in the disaster period.

It will also create awareness among the people about disaster and take necessary precautionary measures when needed, the meeting was informed. The Bureau will take all necessary measures in post disaster relief operations.

The meeting also disclosed that so far a total of 4.8 lakh metric tons of wheat has been distributed under Food for Work programme during the current fiscal year. During the same period about 44 lakh metric tons of wheat had also been distributed for Test Relief Programme, the meeting added.

The State Minister said Bangladesh is a poor and disaster prone country and urged the officers to discharge their responsibilities with honesty, sincerity and dynamism.

Relief Secretary M A Hakim and high officials of the Ministry and concerned directorate attended the meeting.

## Navy sets up medical camp at Patenga

CHITTAGONG, Apr 3: The Bangladesh Navy has set up a medical camp at South Patenga here to provide medical assistance to the local people, reports UNB.

According to a press release issued here today, naval medical teams have already treated a good number of people suffering from different diseases and distributed medicines among them.

Meanwhile, some of the serious patients were being admitted in the camp, it added.

## Death anniversary of Justice Murshed observed

"Murshed fearlessly held aloft the banner of the rule of law" — this was observed at a discussion in observance of the 14th death anniversary of late Chief Justice Syed Mahbub Murshed organized by "Memorial Committee" here yesterday, reports BSS.

The speakers described Justice Murshed as an independent judge who was uncompromising in his principles as he never succumbed to external interference.

The speakers included politicians, judges, lawyers, academicians, and admirers of late Justice Murshed.

Special tribute was paid for Justice Murshed's major participation in the Tagore's centenary and other socio-cultural activities. His role in all democratic movements such as the mass upsurge of 1969 was discussed.

The meeting in a resolution requested the authorities concerned to publish Justice Murshed's biography with emphasis on his historic role and achievements.

Earlier in the morning Quran khwani was held at the mazar premises of Justice Murshed and the members of the memorial committee laid floral wreaths.

## 250 bottles of Phensydil seized

A special squad of the Drug Control Department seized 250 bottles of Phensydil from Gabtoli in the capital and arrested one person in this connection, official sources said here yesterday, reports UNB.

Acting on a secret information, the special squad raided the area and arrested the person. However, two other people allegedly involved with the incident are absconding.

The squad also seized 70 bottles of foreign liquor and 20 bottles of Phensydil in last month, said a press release.

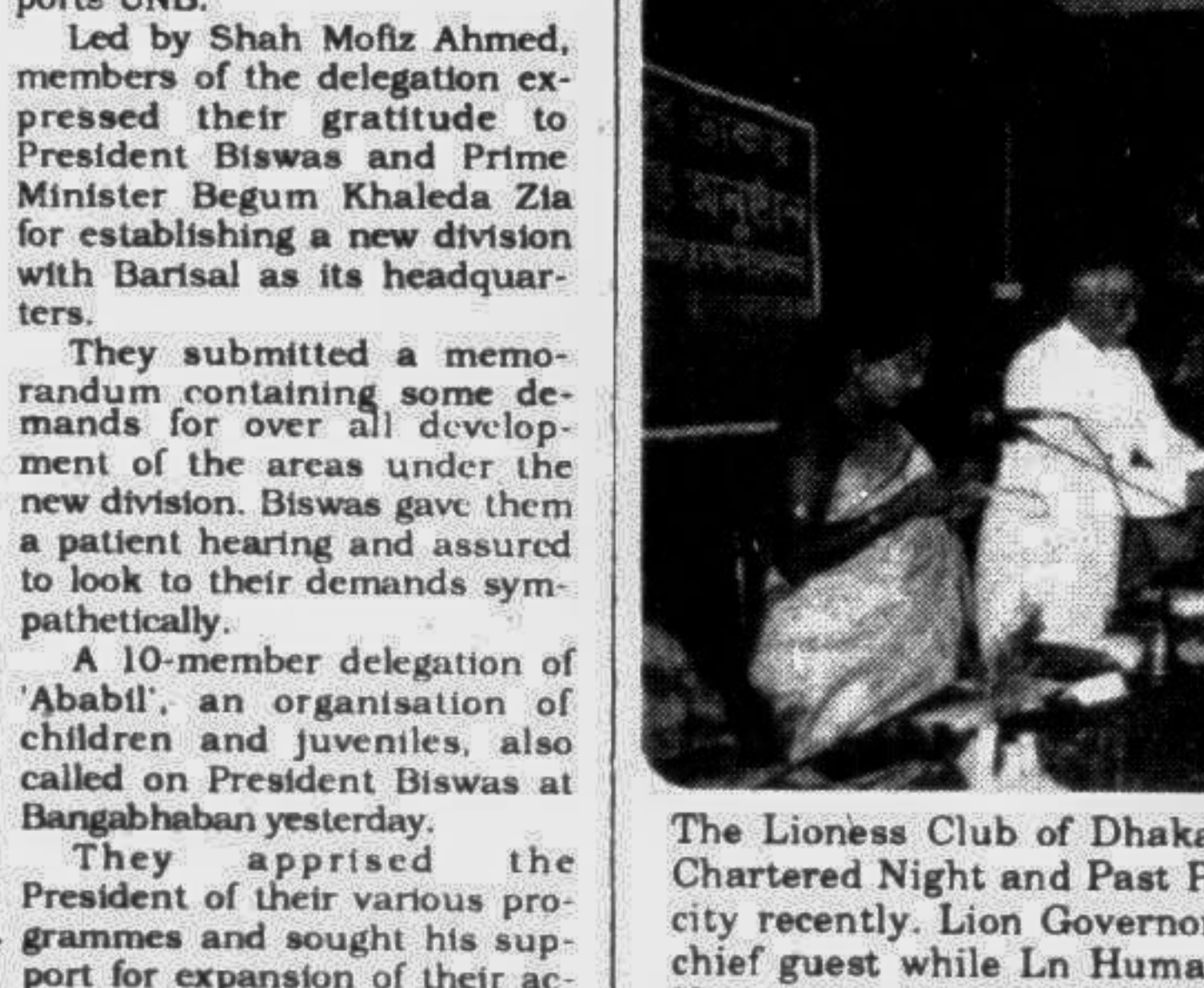
