IUB classes begin from April 15

Independent University Bangladesh (IUB), country's second private university, will begin its first academic session from April 15, reports UNB.

Some 100 students will join the first session for four-year BSc Honours degree in Business Studies, Communication and Environmental Management.

The IUB has included these three main fields in its programme, responding to high demand for employment, new business development and for higher studies.

Its academic plan follows the American system but the course concentration follows the British Honours degree model, said IUB Governing Council President Dr A Majeed Khan at a press conference at the university's business office at Banant yesterday.

Khan said the mission of establishing IUB is to achieve the goals of higher education and sustainable economic growth in the country through a three-way relationship: university, committee for scholar and community.

At present the economy needs qualified new leaders and skilled entrepreneurs, he said and hoped that IUB will be able to produce graduates well-grounded in the liberal arts with marketable skills for economic growth. IUB is committed to developing relevant courses to equip its graduates with the subject knowledge and skills needed to succeed as well as to ensure their high demand and employment prospects, Khan added.

Replying to a question, the IUB President said higher education is for building up leadership qualities. It is not a basic need, its for marketing and needs investment like my any other business venture.

He said the goal of the university is to improve the quality of higher education for producing world class graduates within the local environment, to provide leadership with knowledge and skill.

The news conference was attended by the members of Governing Council and Executive Committee, including Abdul Matin Chowdhury, Wajid Ali Khan Panni, Khalilur Rahman, Towhid Samad, A S H K Sadique, Yasmeen Murshed, Parveen Enam and Dr Anwar Hossain.

DSE to set up institute on share trading, research

Classes at the Securities Training and Research Institute, being set up by the Dhaka Stock Exchange (DSE), will begin this month.

The institute will offer a 12-week course, dealing in various aspects of share trading and other capital market mechanisms, beginning April 10, according to a DSE official on Sunday.

The purpose of the institute is to provide professional training to share market operators which will fulfil a long-term need in a rapidly expanding stock market of the country, he said.

The absence of professional dealers in the stock market is seen by experts as a major drawback in gearing up the capital market at a time when the government is pushing towards a market economy and greater privatisation.

The Asian Development Bank and the Asia Foundation, in separate reports on the development of capital markets, have recommended for setting up an institute for professional operators.

It may be mentioned that bourses in South East Asia do not even allow any one to operate in the share market without adequate professional training.

The course at the institute will include various capital market-related subjects like rules and regulations in the securities market and stock market operation including trading, clearing, settlement, transfer and registration of securities.

The course will also include investment analysis and counselling and subjects related to other capital market instruments.

The classes will be held at the DSE building at Motijheel. The initial administrative and

logistical support for the institute will be provided by the stock exchange, the official said, but the long-term goal is to develop it as a full-fledged institute without outside help.

DSE has already invited applications from persons interested to attend the inaugural course at the institute. Response has been quite good so far, the DSE official said, adding that the Investment Corporation of Bangladesh (ICB) has requested for a quota for its officers.

Classes will be held five days a week, Saturday through Wednesday, during evening hours. Resource persons for administering the course will be from various fields, from both home and abroad, the official added.

The institute will also seek to establish bilateral relation, he said, with a similar institute in South East Asia to set it up along international standards.
