These teams through personal and institutional level communications will motivate people to invest in the national savings projects.

On the occasion, the Dhaka Regional Savings Office arranged a function at the Office of the Dhaka Divisional Commissioner yesterday.

Chaired by the Director of National Savings Directorate Mohammad Abu Taher, the function was attended by Additional Divisional Commissioners of Dhaka Strajul Islam and Nazrul Islam as the chief guest and special guest respectively.

Describing the necessity of savings in a developing country like Bangladesh, the speakers at the function called for making the savings movement into a social one.

They said, in comparison with the other countries the rate of savings in Bangladesh is much lower. It is of utmost importance to develop the habit of savings at mass level to generate internal resources, resist inflation, avoid conditional foreign loan and attain overall socio-economic progress of the country.
