A first day cover of Taka five and a special cancellor will also be used on the occasion.

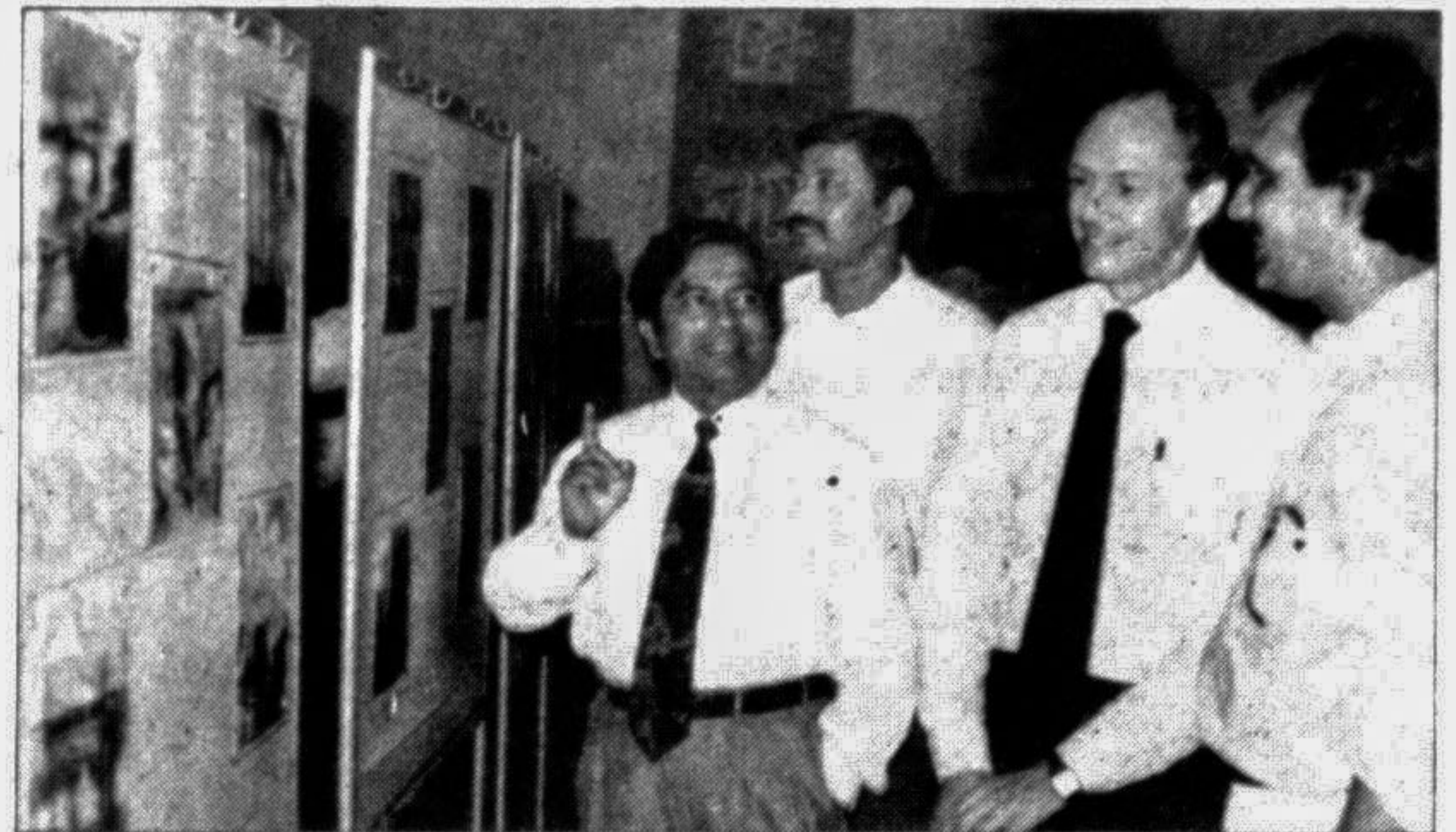
The commemorative stamps will be on sale from today at all the general post offices and later will be available from all subordinate post offices.

'Ekatturer Jishu' makers hold press confce Producer to take legal action against Censor Board

The makers of 'Ekatturer Jishu' (Jesus '71) Tuesday protested and condemned the Censor Board's denial to release the feature film which they claim to be a classic representation of the spirits of the country's glorious Liberation War.

Speaking at a press conference at the Jatiya Press Club, Director of the film Nasruddin Yusuf commented that the board's decision had actually reflected the continued conspiracy against the lofty ideals of the War of Independence.

Bangladesh Film Censor Board on Sunday notified the film makers that it would not approve release of 'Ekatturer Jishu' saying it had distorted historical facts particularly maligning Bangladesh and its ideals and heroes.

"The argument of the board is motivated, concocted insulting and a violation of the freedom of expression," said Yusuf, a valiant freedom fighters.

He vowed to seek justice in the court if the film was denied clearance. "The denial has been made at the behest of the Razakars and Al-Badr's hidden in the government", Yusuf added.

Associate Director of the

makers of 'Ekatturer Jishu' Rafiq Mahmud, Executive Producer David Pranab Das, story writer Shahriar Kabir, photographer Baby Islam, music Director Shimul Yusuf, artiste Zahiruddin Piar and noted film maker Morshedul Islam were present among others at the press conference.

The story of 'Ekatturer Jishu' revolves around the life of Desmond, a bell-ringer of a church in a remote hamlet, during the nine-month gory Liberation War of the country.

Desmond, who makes terracotta statue of Jesus Christ, attains the holy message of the Bible in his own way.

After the March 25, 1971 carnage, mass exodus takes place and people stream into the village and again leave for safer place.

Church fathers and nuns also leave for safer places while Desmond and a mute girl-child live in the empty church.

But the Pakistani soldiers attack the village and Desmond recovers the body of the child from debris of the war.

300 grams of heroin seized in Rajshahi

RAJSHAHI, Apr 13: Members of 20 Rifle battalion seized three hundred grams of heroin from a bordering area of Diarmanikchar under Godagary thana of the district and arrested two smugglers in this connection on April 11, an official handout said today, reports BSS.
