Fortunately, only recently a 'gem-testing centre' in Dhanmondi has opened. It officially came into operation from February '92 but has been working since November '91. A gemtesting centre is actually a sister organization of ver bracelets with turquoise in such shops, you Babylon Garments.

"Arif Muhiuddin Sikdar, a lecturer at the Petroleum Institute and a geologist is our only professional tester," said Murad an employee

of the same organization. "We use modern and scientific instruments, like polar-scope, microscope, UV lamp and of course we have the magnifying glass. For each stone, no matter how precious they are, or how many carats they weigh, we charge 200 taka and within minutes you will know the quality of your gem," he said.

"There are three kinds of stones, you can casily differentiate. Original gems usually have in them some

sort of gemmological inclusions, which bear actually a few original scratch marks while formation. These inclusions are absent in synthetic gems. Their lustre, density, specific gravity, hardness, colours, weight may all be the same, except for these marks. And the imitation ones, just made of glass, may be with the exact colour," Murad
