Milk powder import declines Govt encourages setting up dairy farms in private sector: Noman

CHITTAGONG, Apr 19: Minister for Forest, Livestocks and Environment Abdullah Al-Noman has said that the government was encouraging private entrepreneurs to set up dairy farms to increase milk production in the country, reports BSS.

He said, Taka three crore had been allocated during the current financial year for assisting development of poultry and dairy farms.

Speaking as chief guest at the inaugural function of exhibition of milk cow, calves and oxen near the Circuit House at Dampara here Noman said, the government wanted setting up and development of dairy farms on private initiatives.

The exhibition was held under the auspices of Chittagong Dairy Farm Association. More than 300 milk cows, calves and oxen were brought at the exhibition.

The inaugural function presided over by Chittagong Dairy Farm Association Pre-

sident Muhammad Yusuf Chowdhury was attended by Chittagong City Corporation Mayor Mir Muhammad Nasir Uddin, Secretary of the Ministry of Livestocks and Fisheries A Z M Nasir Uddin and Director of the Livestocks Directorate Dr Nazir Ahmad as special guests. Abdullah Al-Noman said the import of powder milk in the country had declined to some extent as milk production was increasing. He said suitable sites had been selected for setting up dairy and poultry farms at Chittagong, Patuakhali and Magura in the near future.
