She criticised the government party for what she said backing terrorism to establish its hold on different universities, including the Engineering


University. The Awami League chief asked the working people to unite and build a movement against undemocratic activities and misrule of the BNP gov-

# Equal treatment to all communities demanded

Speakers at a rally organised by Bangladesh Hindu Buddhist Christian Solidarity Council Thursday demanded equal treatment to all the religious communities of the country in all aspects.

They alleged that government was patronising the communal forces to serve its vested political interest.

The rally held at the Bangabandhu Avenue yesterday afternoon was addressed among others by Sudhangshu Shekhar Halder MP, Maj Gen (Retd) C R Dutta, Dr Nim Chandra Bhoumik, Advocate Shril Shikdar and Bodhipal Mahathero with T Rozario, President of the Council in the chair.

Accusing the government of encouraging communalism, Sudhangsu Shekhar said, the country would be the ultimate victim of spreading religious fanaticism. "The rights of the minority

groups were reserved by the constitution itself, so why should the government be asked to protect it", he questioned. C R Dutta urged the gov-

ernment to take appropriate and immediate measures to ensure security to the minori-

T Rozario said the actual

causes of discontent of the minority groups lay in their economic condition.

Bodhtpal Mahathero said that minority communities had actively joined the liberation war in 1971 to establish the country as a secular state where people of all religious faiths would live with equal

"We want to live in this country in peace and communal harmony", he said, adding "people of this country are non-communal but the government is communal."

The parishad called for realisation of their 9-point demand which include reconstruction of temples and houses damaged in communal troubles last December and ban on communal politics.

The Parishad also called for compensation to the owners of shops and houses damaged in communal disturbances following the demolition of Babri Mosque in India.

They demanded of the government to take effective steps to stop exodus of minorities to India, scrapping of the Enemy (Vested) Property Act, recognition of the legitimate demands of the tribals and annulling of the 5th and the 8th amendments to the Consti-
