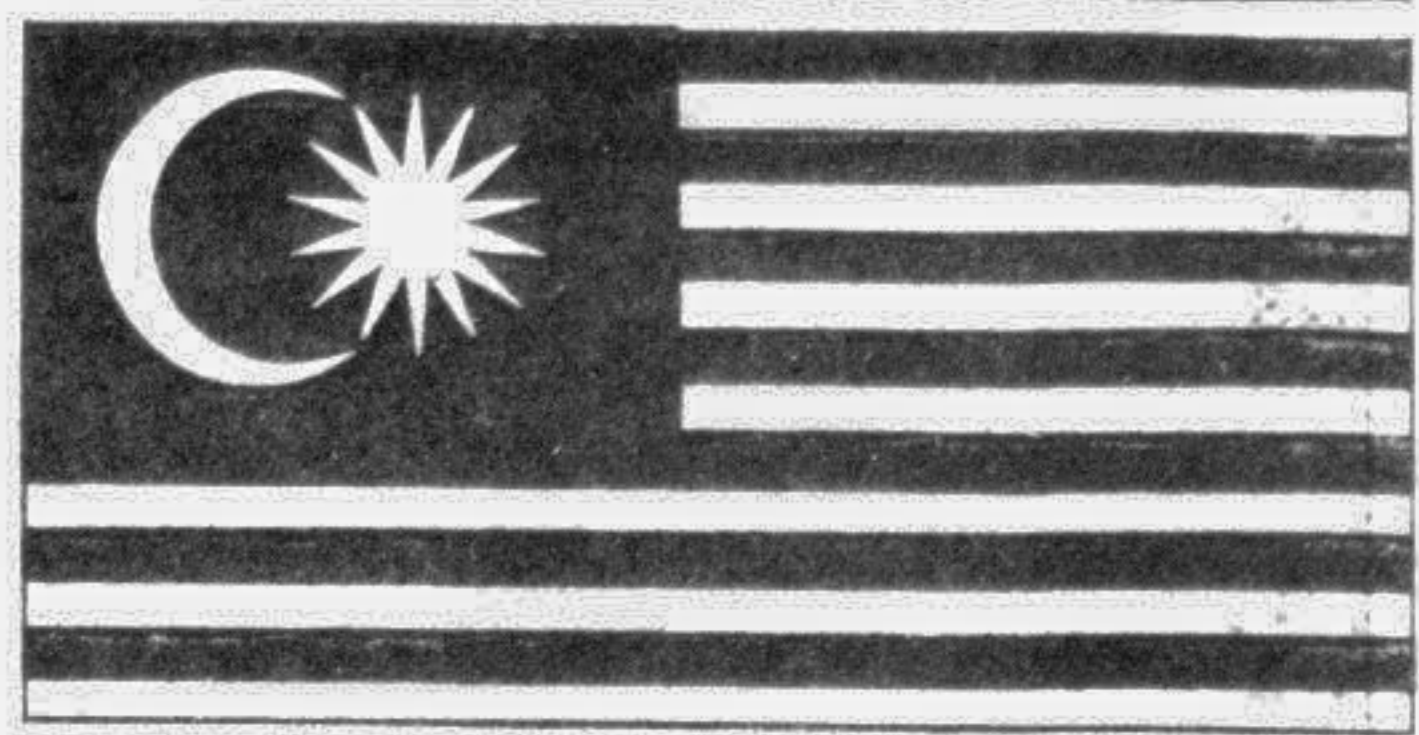

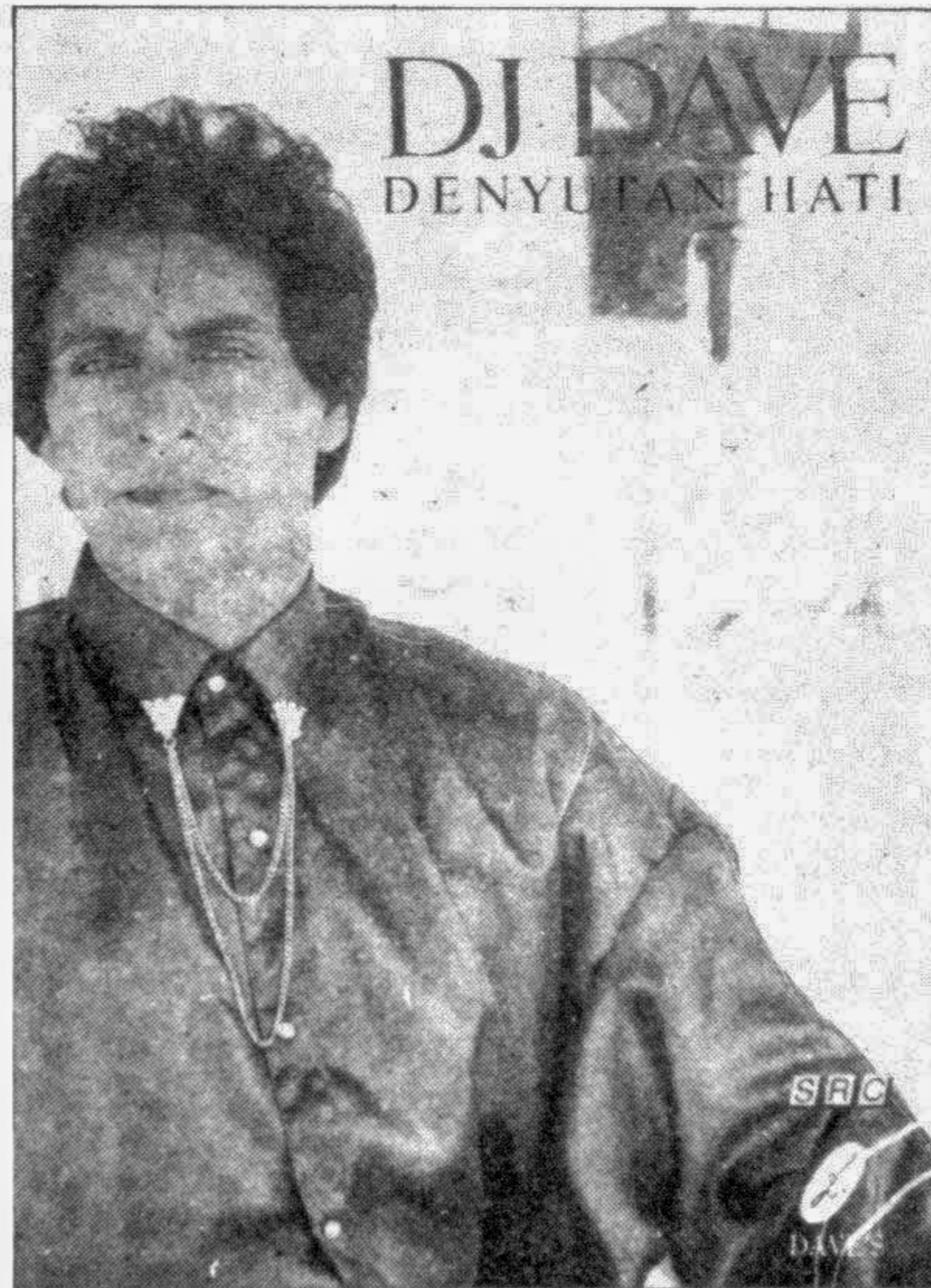
## MESSAGE
