3 missing as boat capsizes in Jamuna

SIKJGANJ, May 3: Three people, including a woman, were reported missing after an engine boat capsized at Shailjana of Chauhali thana in the river Jamuna during storm today (Monday). Witnesses said the boat, with 46 passengers, was proceeding towards Bera of Pabna district from Bhupur. Forty-three passengers swam ashore but the rest three could not be traced, they said, reports UNB.

Kill extremists like dogs: Gaddafi

CAIRO, May 3: Libyan leader Moammar Gaddafi says Muslim extremists are US-backed heretics who should be killed like dogs. Gaddafi, who last month advocated implementing in Libya strict Islamic punishments like severing a thief's hand, attacked militants in a Sunday night speech to Libyan students. It was broadcast on Libyan television and monitored by the British Broadcasting Corporation, reports AP.

Police identify Premadasa's killer as Tamil guerilla

COLOMBO, May 3: Police on Monday identified the suicide bomber who assassinated President Ranasinghe Premadasa as a Tamil guerilla who lived in the capital, a news agency said.

The two men who had been friends of Babu were questioned and released, the sources said.
