South Asia has lost a good friend

Some 100 crore people in the South Asian region have lost a "great friend" with the death of Shri Lankan President Ranasinghe Premadasa, speakers at a discussion said Tuesday.

Paying glowing tributes to the slain leader, they said his commitment to SAARC consolidated the regional unity and cooperation.

They were speaking at the condolence meeting organised by the SAARC Citizens' Forum at the Press Club Auditorium with its convenor Reazuddin Ahmed in the chair. Premadasa was assassinated on Saturday by a suicide bomber when he was leading a May Day parade in Colombo.

The meeting was also addressed, among others, by Social Welfare and Women Affairs Minister Tariqul Islam, Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof Emazuddin Ahmed, Chief Editor of BSS D P Barua, Editor of Bangladesh Times Mahboob Anam, former Presidential Adviser Prof Yazuddin Ahmed, Educationist Dr Ashraf Siddiqi, Whip Mahbul Alam Tara, Selma Hossain MP, Gias Kamal Chowdhury and Suddhananda Mahathora.

Tariqul Islam said that most of the nationalist leaders of the region were the victims of conspiracy.

He said that it was a tragedy and Bangladesh lost a true friend. Prof Emazuddin Ahmed said that the slain President successfully withstand several blows to SAARC.

Ad distribution policy to be amended

The leaders of Bangladesh Sangbadpatri Parishad (BSP) yesterday called on Information Minister Nazmul Huda in his Secretariat office here, reports BSS.

Scouts urged to work for uplift

President Abdur Rahman Biswas Tuesday commended the scouts for their services in different areas and called for further strengthening their movement to motivate the young generations to work for country's continued development and people's welfare, reports BSS.

The juvenile community should be built up as a disciplined force through the scout movement so that they can dedicate themselves to the service of the humanity, he said.

President Biswas, who is also the chief scout, was inaugurating the 20th annual general meeting of the national council of Bangladesh Scouts at the Jatiya Scout Bhaban.

With president of Bangladesh Scouts Mohammad Mahbubuzzaman in the chair, the inaugural function was also addressed by chief national commissioner Manzur-ul-Karim, and national commissioner (organisation) Badrot Rahman, the president said.

He called upon all to rise above self interest and put in their united endeavours to achieve national progress and prosperity.

He also called upon the young generation to become imbued with the sense of patriotism and discipline

ensured through united efforts, based on creativity and constructive attitude.

He appreciated the role of scouts in disaster relief and rehabilitation, implementing baby-health programmes and maintaining environmental balance and afforestation.

"Simultaneously, they should be more active in spreading education and nation building task," he said adding, the nation expects a wide participation of scouts in the removal of illiteracy from the country.

President Biswas said, "as a nation we are proud although the size of our country is small. Our patriotism, sacrifices, history, culture and tradition have made us an independent nation."

He said the construction the 15-storied Bangladesh scouts building was completed but there is paucity of funds to meet its construction cost.

The chief national commissioner congratulated the present government for incorporating Bangladesh scouts in the annual development plan from the current fiscal year and expressed the hope that the crisis would be over in the next fiscal year.

Referring to the growth plan, Karim said Bangladesh scouts had embarked upon an ambitious plan to increase the number of members to 10 lakh in the next ten years from the present level of 3.91 lakh.
