JAGPA demands release of Prophan

Jatiya Ganatantrik Party (JAGPA) brought out a procession demanding release of its President Shaful Alam Prophan and cancellation of SAPTA and the 'black laws of 1974 and 1992'. In a rally held at Parana Paltan followed by the procession, terming the present BNP rule as 'black chapter of the country', JAGPA leaders said that instead of repealing the black laws of '74, the government was imposing new black laws. The rally presided over by Dr Aziz was addressed, among others, by A K M Masud, M A Ahad, Sardar Shahjahan and Mofizur Rahman Alo. The leaders blamed the government for leasing out the economy of Bangladesh to India through the SAPTA and demanded release of all political prisoners.

SAPTA to accelerate mutual trade, says Anwar

The visiting 14-member Indian delegation of exporters of cotton textiles to Bangladesh, led by the Vice-Chairman and Managing Director of Asher Textiles Ltd. P D Patodia, had a meeting with the Commerce Minister M K Anwar at the Secretariat here yesterday, reports BSS. Senior officials of the Ministries of Commerce and Foreign Affairs were present. Commerce Minister described the past and present conditions of the textile industry of Bangladesh and said that the government was following a liberal and deregulatory trade and industrial policy over the last few years under which the private industries were getting momentum. The main objective of the government's trade policy was to reach the daily necessary items to the consumers at a reasonable price under a free, uncontrolled and competitive market, he said. Anwar said that the mutual trade among the South Asian countries would be more dynamic and smooth under the South Asian Preferential Trade Arrangement (SAPTA) recently signed in the 7th SAARC summit in Dhaka. He said the member countries would determine preferential exportable items and then proceed for further details for promoting trade relations. Anwar said that the tariff and other duties among the SAARC countries might be reduced under SAPTA. However, it will be necessary to take care and precaution in formulating the details of the agreement so that the interests of each member country are protected, he said. The leader of the Indian delegation expressed his hope that the trade relations between India and Bangladesh would be further consolidated in the years to come. The members of the delegation expressed keen interest in establishing industries in Bangladesh on joint venture. The import of textile items from India had been increased during the last few years. Last year, Bangladesh imported textile items worth Taka 486 crore and 61 lakh from India against Taka 37 crore and 38 lakh in the previous year. Textile items worth Taka 313 crore and 20 lakh have been imported during the first seven months of the current fiscal year also from India.

Russian envoy meets NSU President

Ambassador of the Russian Federation to Bangladesh ES Shevchenko met with President (Vice-Chancellor) of the North South University (NSU), Muslehuddin Ahmad here Tuesday and discussed academic programmes of the university, reports UNB. During the meeting at the administrative office of the university, they also discussed the possibilities of mutual co-operation in the field of higher education. The Russian envoy appreciated the unique efforts of the sponsors for setting up the first private university in the country. North South University is the first government approved degree awarding private university in Bangladesh. NSU presently offers under graduate courses in Economics, Business Administration and Computer Science.

- Minimum Qualification:
 - Undergraduate: No third class in SSC & HSC results (or O/A level equivalent) for tribal candidates. Two first class SSC & HSC results (or O/A level equivalent) for non tribal candidates.
 - Postgraduate: No third class SSC/HSC/undergraduate results (or O/A level equivalent): Minimum four years undergraduate or combined undergraduate/postgraduate course (s) passed for tribal candidates. Minimum two first class and no third class SSC/HSC/undergraduate results (or O/A level equivalent): Minimum four years undergraduate or combined undergraduate/postgraduate course (s) passed for non-tribal candidates.

- Candidates fulfilling the above conditions may apply in English on plain paper with two copies of passport size photographs, certificates and marksheets (Two sets, duly attested) and two copies of bio-data in English. The bio-data should contain name, Father's/Guardian's name, Present and Permanent address (Telephone No., if any), Date of Birth, Age, as on 1.1.94, Educational Qualification, Name of Board/University, Year of passing, Division/Class total and average marks in each Examination, total and average marks of the Exams, and the name of the proposed subject of study. The candidates must submit their reason of interest in the particular subject in a separate sheet of paper in English.

- The decision of the authority shall be final.

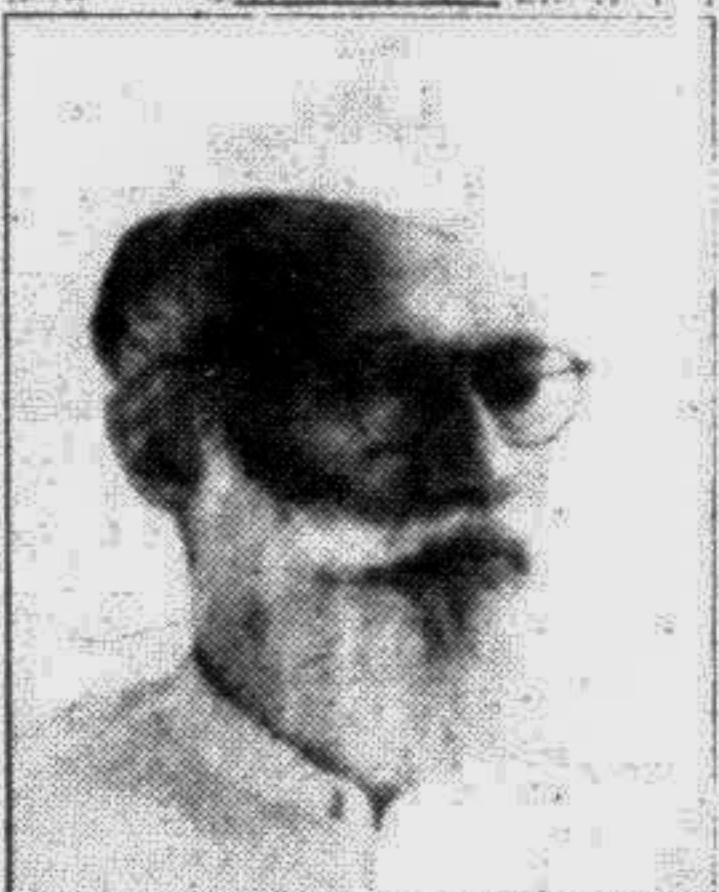
