Dollar weakens, gold firms in New York

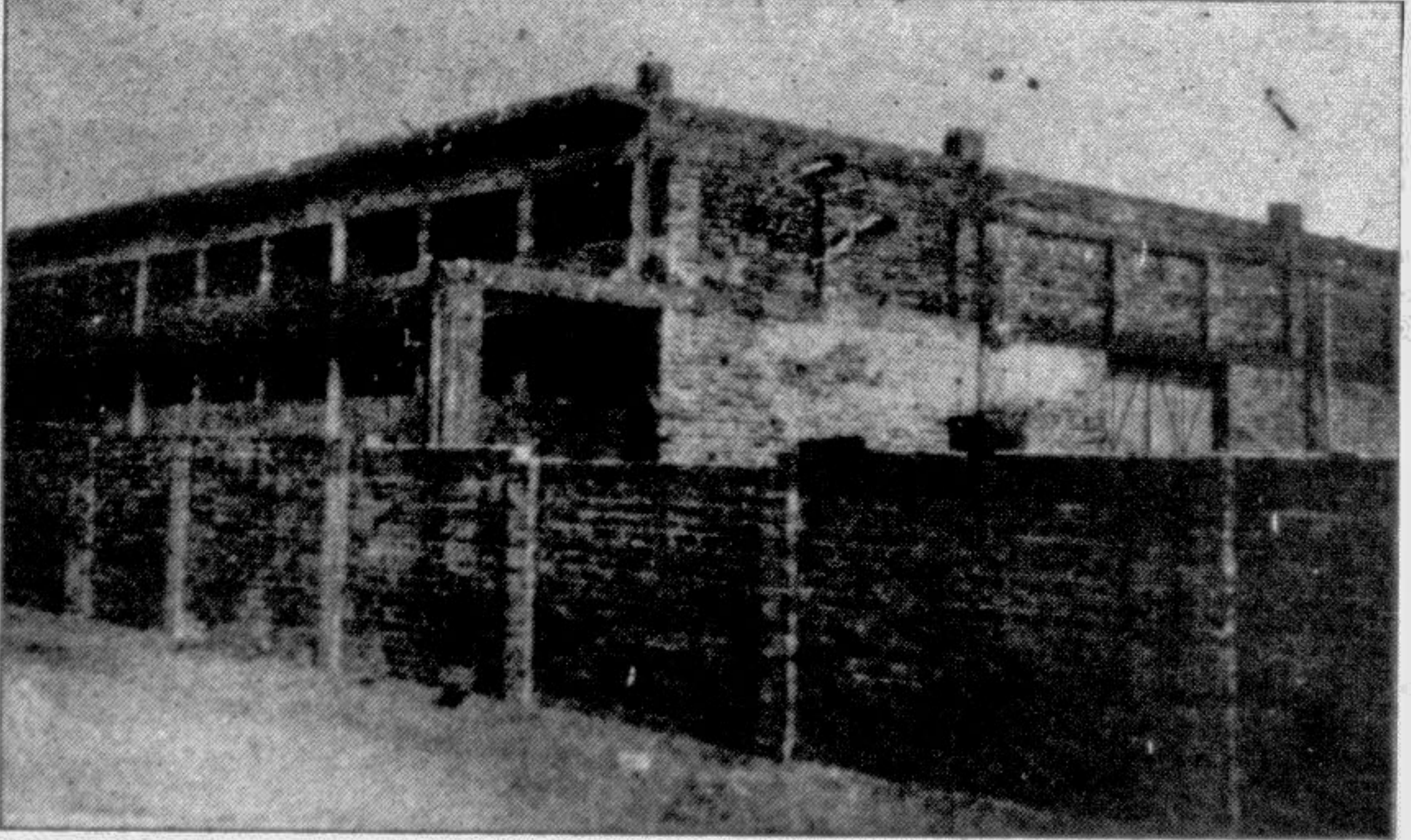
