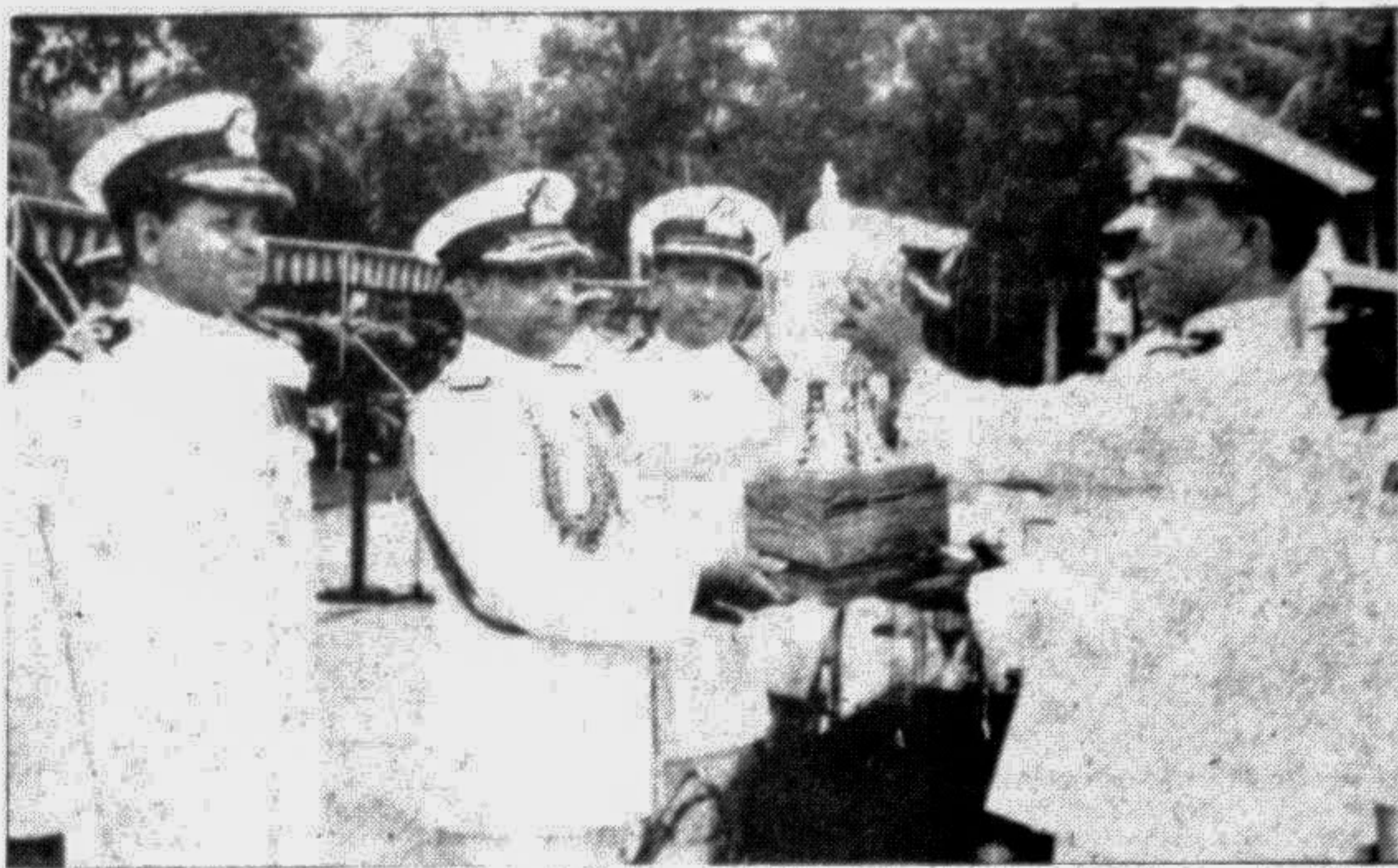
Biswas, Khaleda greet King, PM of Norway

Tk 135 cr water treatment plant to be built in Rajshahi soon

RAJSHAHI, May 16: Speakers at a seminar on "Improvement of sanitation system in Rajshahi City Corporation Area" today emphasised the need for providing health education among the people to improve sanitation system, reports BSS.

The Mayor said construction work of a water treatment plant at a cost of Taka about 135 crore with Japanese assistance would start in the next fiscal year.

"It will help mitigate problem of pure drinking water of the Rajshahi city dwellers," he said. The present acute water problem will be solved within one month after commissioning six machines and 21 km water pipe line, he added.

The Mayor said there was no master plan of the former municipality since its inception in 1876 to meet up sanitation, sewerage and water problem. However, he said, present government was trying hard to overcome the problems.

The Mayor announced that the city corporation henceforth will supply two-pit low cost sanitary latrines at the subsidised rate of Taka one thousand per set and one-pit latrine at the rate of Taka 500 per set.

Overall development of the country would not be achieved without making the masses healthy and educated, he said adding coordinated and concerted efforts of all was imperative in this regard.

The speakers said only six per cent people of the country use sanitary latrine. Only the physicians and medicine would not ensure good health, rather awareness among the people have to be created to use sanitary latrine, they opined.

In-depth study on industrial situation needed: Zahir

The first meeting of the inter-ministerial committee for restructuring mills and factories of the corporations under the Industries Ministry was held yesterday at the Industries Ministry with its Convener Industries Minister Shamsul Islam Khan in the chair, reports BSS.

The meeting had detailed discussions on the present situation of different industrial units of the ministry, an official source said.

Planning Minister and the member of the committee, A M Zahiruddin Khan emphasised the need for in-depth study on the present situation of each industrial unit for specifically pointing out the causes of losses.

The Industries Minister said that this committee will work to prepare meaningful recommendations to turn the losing industrial units into profitable ones.

The meeting decided that study work will be done on 22 industrial units out of 63 under the ministry.

Biman's hajj flights on schedule

Biman Bangladesh Airlines had flown over 6,000 Hajj pilgrims to Jeddah by 21 special Hajj flights till yesterday, reports BSS.

The 22nd special Hajj flight of the airlines left Dhaka at midnight last night with another 301 pilgrims.

Biman will operate 27 special Hajj flights this year to transport 8,100 pilgrims. The special flights of the airlines commenced from May One.

According to airport departure control sources, all Biman special Hajj flights so far have operated on schedule.

In addition to the ballotee Hajj pilgrims, Biman is expected to carry about 2,000 non-ballotee pilgrims this year by its scheduled flights to Jeddah. Presently, Biman operates two 310-seat capacity wide-bodied DC-10 flights a week between Dhaka and Jeddah.

So far Biman has carried 300 non-ballotee Hajj pilgrims by its scheduled flights to Jeddah.

Biman sources said the airlines is planning additional flights between Dhaka and Jeddah to transport non-ballotee pilgrims.

Meanwhile, Biman's international schedule has been adversely affected due to severe aircraft constraints following the withdrawal of one DC-10 aircraft from its modest fleet of four.

The national flag carrier presently flies to 29 international destinations.

With its small fleet of four DC-10-30 aircraft Biman has been maintaining an impressive flying hour record per aircraft of over 13 hours, Biman sources claimed.
