Mixed reaction over JU VC's action By JU Correspondent

There was mixed reaction among the teachers of the Jahangirnagar University yesterday at the rescinding of the expulsion orders against two student leaders by the Vice Chancellor Monday in the presence of the Information Minister.

"The decision of the Vice Chancellor has to be ratified by the Syndicate within seven days, as per varsity regulation." said President of the Jahangirnagar University Teachers' Association (JUTA) Professor Khandaker Mustahidur Rahman while talking to The Daily Star over telephone Tuesday.

"If the VC really wanted to invoke his special power to resolve the crisis over the expulsion issue, he could have done it much earlier," opined Prof Khandaker, who is also a Syndicate member.

Vice Chancellor and head of the Syndicate Prof Kazi Saleh Ahmed used his special powers under Section 12 (3) of the University Ordinance, 1973 to retract the Syndicate's punitive measures against two students expelled earlier from the university for their alleged misdemeanour with a hall provost.

The JCD activists resorted to a hunger strike 'unto death' Sunday following a series of violent incidents centred around its demand for withdrawal of the expulsion orders. Irked by the Syndicate's

punishment, JCD activists opened fire, observed strikes, ransacked teachers' rooms and even suspended the plying of the varsity transport on several occasions. Two cabinet ministers had to intervene on December 3

"Expelling students for a year for a reported misbehaviour is to severe," the teacher added, hoping nor malcy would now be restored in the campus. Another teacher felt that

the government minister should not have interfered in the varsity's affair. "The crisis could have been

easily solved by the university itself," he added.


