

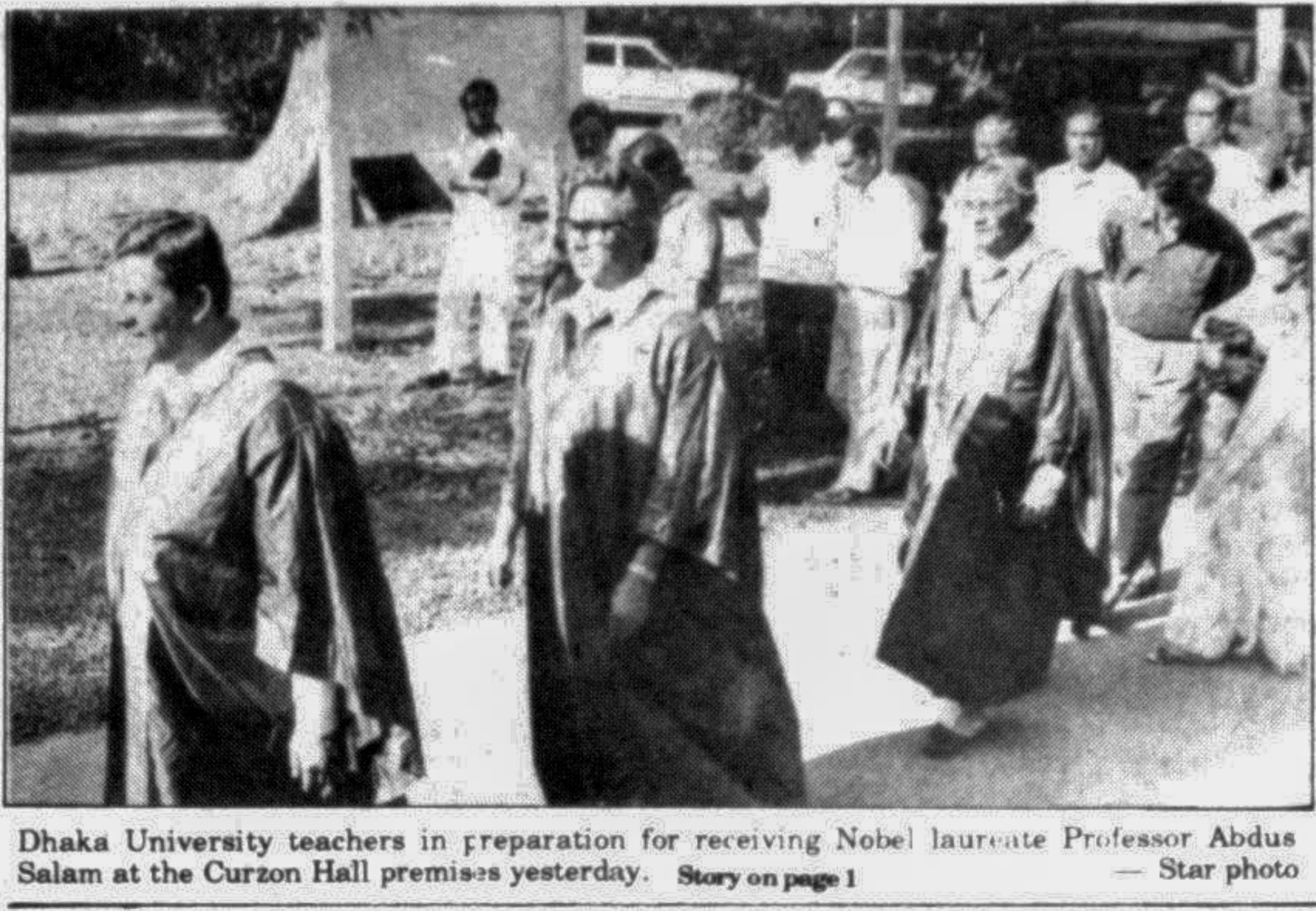

**Orientation course for environment journalists begins**  
**Use of home technology can save forestry: Badruddoza**

An eight-day orientation course for environment journalists, jointly organised by the Panos Institute of London and the Press Institute of Bangladesh (PIB) was inaugurated yesterday, reports UNB.

Prof. Badruddoza Chowdhury, Deputy Leader of the Jatiya Sangsad was present as chief guest. The function was presided over by Gazi Shamsur Rahman, Chairman of the PIB Management Board.

The Panos Institute with support from Ford Foundation is providing ten fellowships for 1993.

The fellows, after the orientation course would work on environment problems relevant to Bangladesh by visiting different SAARC and ASEAN countries.

Prof. Badruddoza in his inaugural speech gave emphasis on the need of environmental education for improving the quality of life of people. We should solve our problems ourselves instead of depending on foreign experts, he added.

Some problems like sanitation, forestry can be solved in simple ways by using indigenous technology instead of technology borrowed from developed countries, the Deputy Leader of the Jatiya Sangsad added.

Additional Secretary of the Ministry of Information Md. Moqlesur Rahman, emphasised the need for training of journalist to upgrade their professional skills to create awareness about environment problems.

Prof. Tawhidul Anwar, Director General of PIB who is also the coordinator of the Panos Fellowship Committee, in his welcome speech thanked the Panos Institute for sponsoring the fellowship programme for Bangladeshi journalists.

Carmen Miranda, Director, South Asia Regional Programme, Panos Institute, explained the aims and objectives of the fellowship programme.

Tahmina Ahmed, member of the Fellowship Committee and Mostafa Kamal, coordinator of the course also spoke on the occasion.

**WASA Consumers' Assoc**  
 A meeting was held at Tikatully in the city recently with former minister AK Faezul Huq for formation of Dhaka WASA Consumers' Association.

 A seven-day long training course on 'Primary Health Care' organised by Shishu Sastha Foundation, Bangladesh ended in its Central Office-6/2, Barabag Section-2, Mirpur recently.

Major General (Retd) Majid-ul-Huq, Minister for Agriculture and Irrigation, Water Development and Flood Control was the chief guest at the concluding session and distributed the Certificates among the trainees.

**BPKS**  
 Speakers at a meeting here emphasised that the persons with disabilities should be made aware first to solve their problems.

The observation came at a meeting of the National Forum of the Organisations Working with the Disabled (NFOWD), held on Thursday at the central office of the Bangladesh Protibondhi Kallyan Somity (BPKS).

The meeting focussed on different programmes taken up by BPKS for the welfare of the disabled since its inception in the year 1985.

BPKS has so far provided employment to 72 disable people under its job placement programme and given typewriting training to 44 disabled.

**Computer training**  
 Some 240 women have been imparted computer training from the Computer Training Centre being run by Women's Affairs Department.

The course was launched in July only for women. Three such courses have so far been completed. Each course was conducted in three batches.

**Tk 6 cr project launched to promote pvt libraries**

The government is implementing a Taka six crore project during the current five-year-plan period aiming at promoting the private libraries at district and thana levels, reports BSS.

This was stated at a conference of the Bangladesh Grantha Suhreed Samity held at the auditorium of Bangladesh National Book Centre here yesterday morning. Presided over by Cultural Secretary Islamuddin Malik the day long conference was formally inaugurated by State Minister for Cultural Affairs Prof. Jahannara Begum said that 13 thousands workers of 12 hundred "Grantha Suhreed Samity" are working in Bangladesh to popularise the reading habit. But she observed, that as per requirement the number of field workers are not sufficient. She underlined the need for making at least one worker in each of the 68 thousand villages of the country.

The State Minister called upon the concerned persons to inform the government of the actual demand of book so that government could supply useful books to the libraries in the country. Stressing the need for women's participation in this programme, she said concerted efforts of men and women were essential for the prosperity.
