Iran assures to solve problems of Bangladeshi physicians

Information Minister Nazmul Huda left Tehran yesterday afternoon for home at the end of his three-day official visit to the Islamic Republic of Iran, an official handout said here last night, reports BSS.

He was given a hearty send-off at the Tehran's Mehrabad airport by the President of the Islamic Republic of Iran Broadcasting, Dr Muhammad Hashemi. The ambassador and members of Bangladesh embassy in Tehran were also present at the airport.

The Information Minister had a busy day yesterday meeting with Iran's first Vice-President Dr Hassan Habibi and visiting the IRNA office, the official news agency of Iran.

During the meeting with Dr Habibi, who is also the Chief of the Cultural Revolutionary

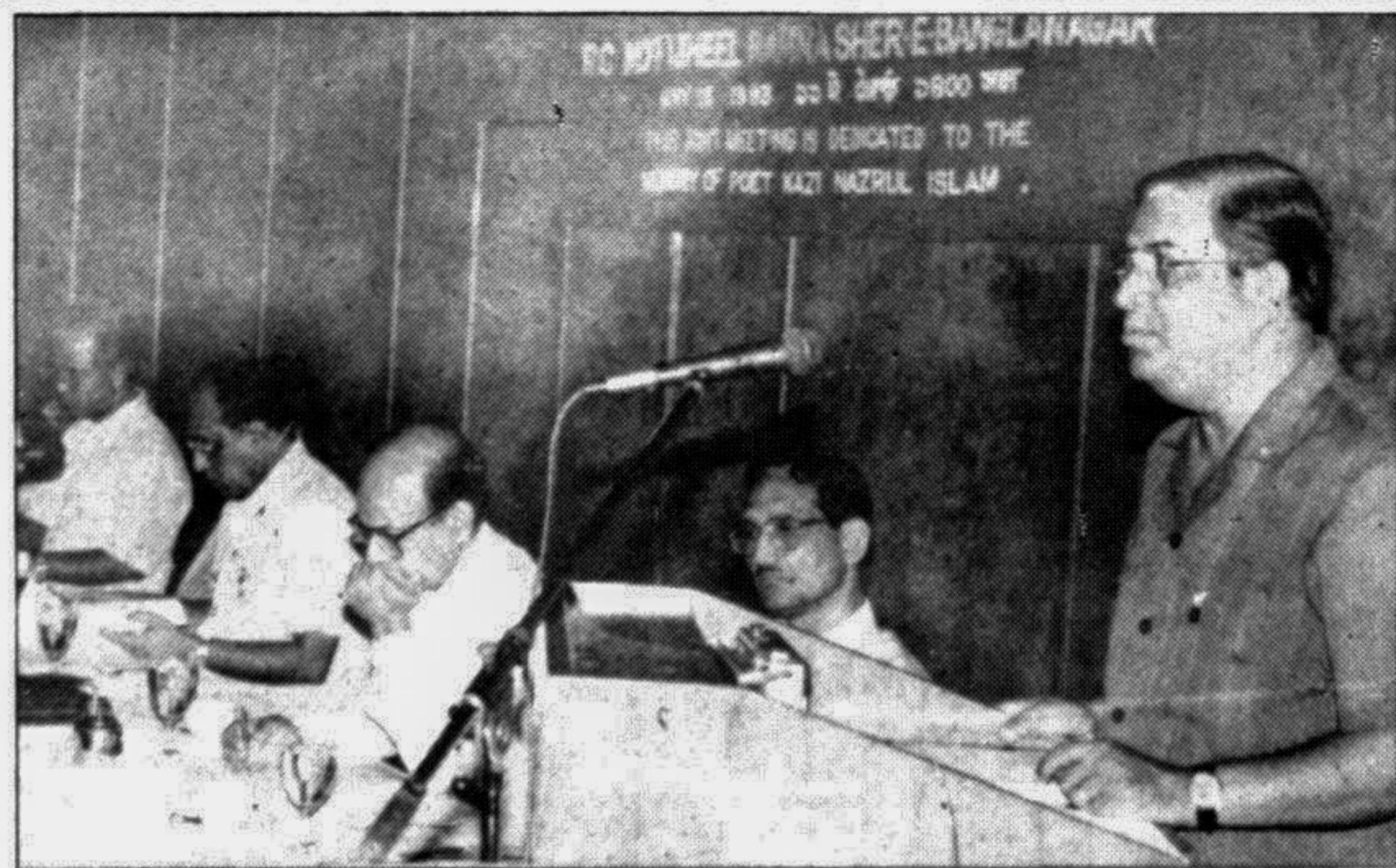
Committee and member of the Guardian and Expediency Council, Barrister Nazmul Huda conveyed the greetings of Bangladesh government and its people which were highly reciprocated.

Nazmul Huda highlighted some important aspects of bilateral relations between Bangladesh and Iran and Dr Habibi had agreed with him saying the full potential of the relations between the two countries needed to be realised with renewed efforts by the two sides for their mutual benefits.

The Bangladesh Information Minister also apprised Dr Habibi of the difficulties being faced by Bangladeshi doctors serving the Iranian Ministry of Health and the unauthorized Bangladeshi working in Iran. Upon Bangladesh minister

request, the Iranian Vice-President assured that he would instruct the concerned ministers with a view to resolving the problems of Bangladeshi doctors and also to expedite the process of legalization of Bangladeshis with unauthorized status in Iran.

The Information Minister visited the principal office of the Islamic Republic News Agency. He was briefed by the chief of IRNA on the various facilities and modern methods being utilised by the organisation for receiving, editing, collecting and transmitting news to and from Iran. The minister went round the IRNA premises and inspected the fully computerised news room, advanced news monitoring unit, the data bank and the computer main frame section of the agency.

He left behind his two wives, two daughters and a son to mourn his death.

Tea sale marks fairly good demand in Ctg

CHITTAGONG, May 25: The weekly tea sale held here today was marked by fairly good demand, specially for smaller brokens and good fannings, market sources said, reports BSS.

Larger and bolder brokens were only steadily to sometimes slightly easier following a limited buyers operating from Poland.

Internal buyers operated strongly and lent useful support for the best liquoring varieties.

Larger and bold brokens were in good demand and were generally steady to sometimes slightly easier. Small brokens were a stronger market and were firm to dearer by upto Tk 1 per kg. A few popular types sold at higher rates and realised between Tk 54/30 and Tk 55/80 per kg.

In the fannings category, the good liquoring types met with a strong demand and were dearer by upto Tk 1 per kg to sometimes more while medium and plainer types were fully firm. The popular types realised higher rates and sold between Tk 54/60 and Tk 56/80 per kg.

Two thousand and sixty three chests and 25 bags of dust category on offer continued to meet with a strong demand with prices on again appreciating around Tk 1 per kg in seller's favour.

Internal buyers lent good support along with some export enquiries.

There were 12,794 chests and 27 bags of teas on offer.
