

Adopt modern pisciculture method: Hannan Shah

KAPASIA (Gazipur), June 5: Jute Minister ASM Hannan Shah has urged the people to adopt scientific pisciculture method to meet the country's nutrition requirement, reports BSS.

He was speaking at the inauguration ceremony of a private sector agriculture and fisheries farm here today.

The function was also addressed by Advocate Mominur Rahman, Managing Director of the newly established farm.

Hannan Shah urged the people to establish this type of agricultural and fisheries farm

in private initiative. The Minister unveiled the plaque of the farm and planted sapling in its premises.

There are six tanks on 17 acres of land in the farm.

Later, the Jute Minister visited and witnessed fishing in a tank under a project in Kapasia where the government has undertaken a fisheries development project with the technical assistance of Manila based International Centre for Living Aquatic Resources Management (ICLARM) in 1990-91 financial year.

There are 605 private tanks

on 13571 decimel of land under this project in six different unions of Kapasia thana. The project experts offer both technical and marketing support to the tank owners.

In the afternoon the Minister inaugurated a three-day long leadership training seminar jointly organised by Bangladesh primary teachers association and education international at Kapasia thana auditorium.

Presided over by Nuruddin Solatman, the function was also addressed by some local educationists and social workers.

India, Israel trade forecast to rise by 40 per cent

NEW DELHI, June 5: Trade between India and Israel is expected to increase by 30 to 40 per cent in the next five years, reports Xinhua.

Israel Ambassador to India, Aphirom Doweik said at a meeting in western Indian city of Ahmedabad Friday that the trade grew by 46 per cent in 1992-93, the first year after the two countries established diplomatic relations.

The Ambassador said that about 20 joint ventures were in the pipeline, including two large textile units and a phosphoric acid plant.

Russian central bank boss dismisses real interest rates as impossible

MOSCOW, June 5: Russia's Conservative Central Bank BOSS, pouring cold water on a recent anti-inflation deal, has dismissed real interest rates as impossible in Russia and vowed to quit if his rows with the government become unmanageable, reports Reuter.

"If we reach the point when our opinions differ with the government on the speed and aspects of economic reforms, we will simply split up in a civilised way," Viktor Gerashchenko told commonwealth television late on Friday.

Moscow bankers and economists have watched with increasing frustration a long-running policy tug-of-war between Gerashchenko and the reformist Finance Minister Boris Yodorf.

The fight against inflation has been delayed as the two scorn enemies have traded insults for much of 1993, with Gerashchenko calling Yodorf a "charlatan" and the Finance Minister accusing the bank Governor of being a "saboteur."

The two sides pledged to cut monthly inflation to below 10 per cent from 20 per cent now in a policy statement signed in the presence of the International Monetary Fund

Dhaka Stock Exchange floor met with a dull day of trading on Saturday. Business seemed to head for the bottom. Participation of member companies (20) trading on the day appeared quite disappointing.

Volume and value both recorded losses. Volume suffered a loss of more than 78 per cent and closed at 1,852 issues as against last Monday's 8,456 issues.

Value fell to Taka 129361.00 from Monday's Taka 343,511.00, a decline of 66.26 per cent.

The floor gave way to eight gainers while only four lost prices. Another four companies traded of previous rates.

Changes in prices were noticeable in Milon Tannery and Alpha Tobacco. Milon Tannery suffered a heavy loss of 25 per cent while Alpha Tobacco showed a price gain of 15 per cent.

The index stood at 377.3493.
