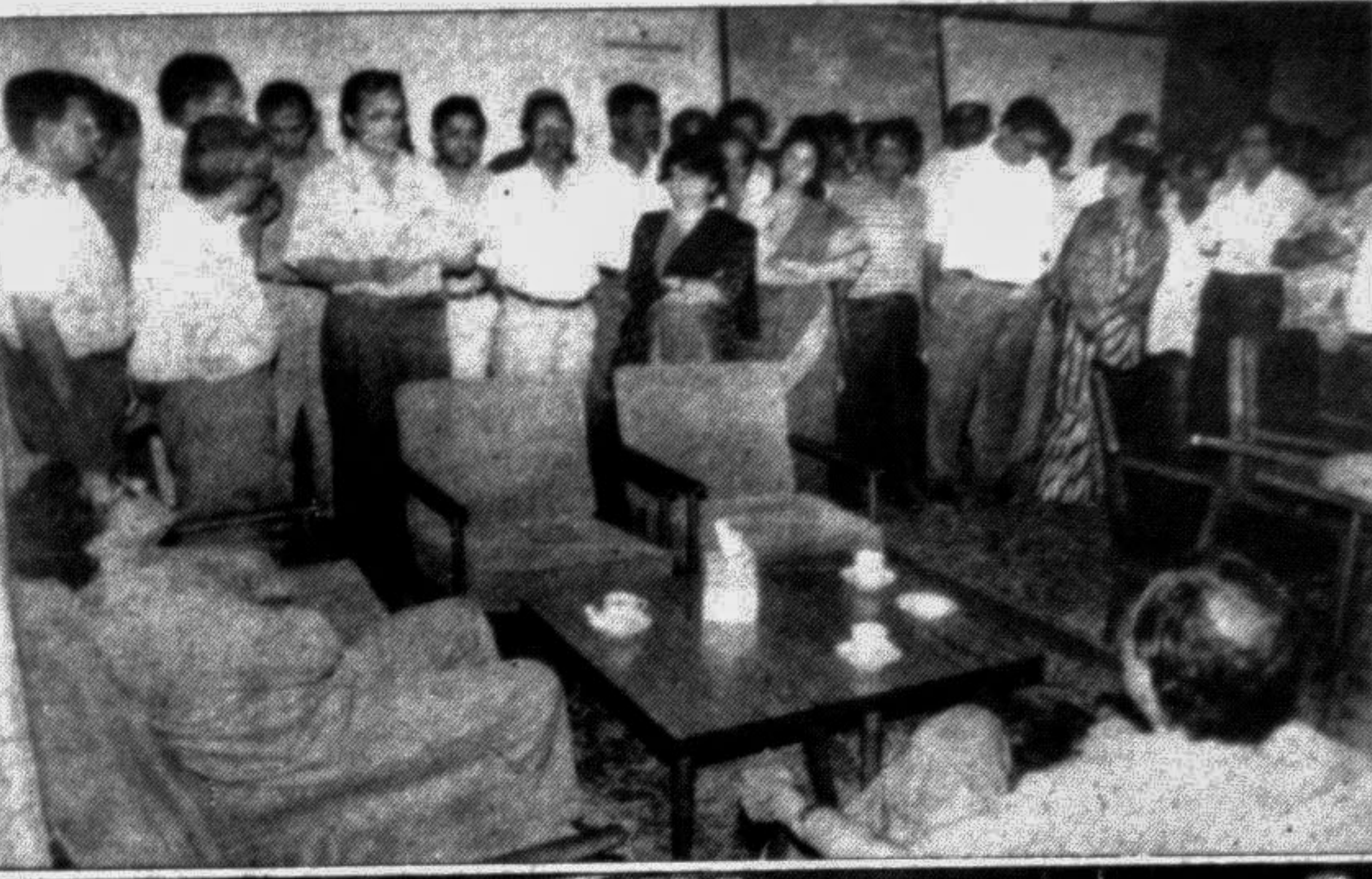

Jute spinners feel left out

Leaders of different trade bodies Friday expressed mixed reactions to the proposed national budget for the fiscal year 1993-94. While some hailed the budget, describing it as a pragmatic package that would lead to a vibrant and dynamic economy, others were less enthusiastic, saying the budget proposals lacked sense of direction.

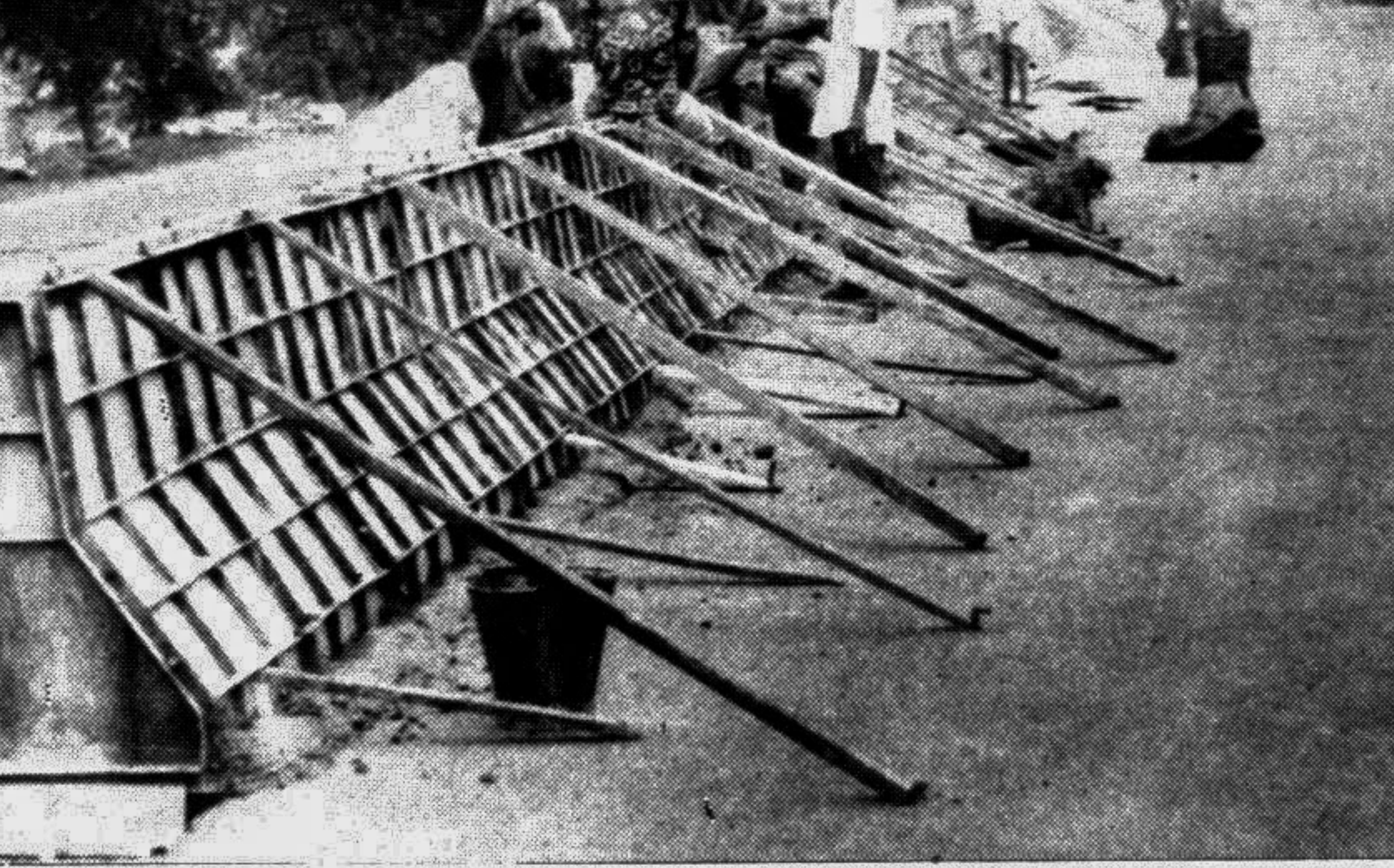
The Bangladesh Jute Spinners' Association hailed the national budget, terming it 'objective and laudable'. The association observed that benefits promised by the proposals in the budget would depend on proper implementation.

In a statement yesterday the Association, however, regretted that the proposed budget had failed to give any guideline on how to get over the present crisis in the jute and jute spinning sector.

The Spinners' Association called for introducing export incentives for the jute sector for reestablishing the 'golden fibre' in the international market.

It also suggested fixing of a consistent tariff value and reduction of bank rate to nine per cent from the current 14 per cent.

Although the budget had proposed some tax reductions in cotton and spare parts of textile machinery, yet the measures would not help rejuvenate the textile industries, they observed.



Construction work of a road-divider on the Dhaka-Chittagong highway in progress. — Star photo

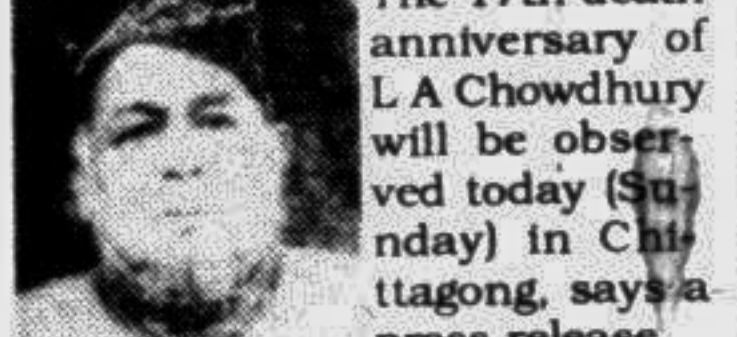
