Biman had 20 mishaps in 21 years, JS told

In 21 years till May 18 this year, aircraft of Biman Bangladesh Airlines met with accident 20 times, parliament was told yesterday, reports UNB.

The accidents incurred a loss of more than 4 crore US dollars, State Minister for Civil Aviation and Tourism Abdul Mannan said replying to Shajahan Khan (AL) during question hour.

According to a break-up given by the minister, the first accident on February 10, 1972 incurred a loss of Tk 4 lakh. The latest mishap took place on May 18 this year, of which the loss is yet to be determined by the insurance company.

Besides, aircraft of the Flying Club met with accident four times, aircraft of Plant Protection Department five times, aircraft of government transport department once and aircraft of foreign airlines on two occasions.

Reasons of the accidents included fault of pilot, bad weather and mechanical troubles.

Replying to Rahmani Ali (AL), the State Minister said that Biman has a total fleet of eight aircraft. At present, three DC-10-30 and two F-28 aircraft fly on 25 international routes.

The minister told the House that 119 pilots, including one woman pilot, are now in service with Biman.

Japanese help sought to develop roads

Bangladesh has proposed for continued Japanese economic assistance in the development of road communication network in the country, reports BSS.

Communications Minister Oli Ahmed Sunday proposed this to Japan through Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) when its Vice-President Tsuyoshi Kurokawa called on the minister at his secretariat office.

WDB achieves 70 pc progress

Seventy per cent physical progress and 66 per cent financial progress have been achieved so far in the work of Bangladesh Water Development Board (WDB) in the current fiscal year, according to a WDB press release yesterday.

The progress is, however, expected to rise to 80 per cent at the end of the fiscal year as against 52 and 57 per cent of the previous fiscal years.

This was disclosed at an Inter-ministerial Review meeting held Monday at the WDB conference room with State Minister for Irrigation Mosharrar Hossain Shahjahan in the chair.

Irrigation Secretary M Asafuddiniah, high ranking officials of the ministry and representatives from WDB, ERD, Planning Commission and Implementation, Monitoring and Evaluation Division attended the meeting.

The meeting decided to strengthen the Planning Division of the WDB with experts of different disciplines.
