## 10 textile mills to be transferred to private ownership, JS told

State Minister for Textiles Major (Retd) Abdul Mannan informed the Jatiya Sangsad here yesterday that the government had decided to transfer 10 textile mills to private ownership under its denationalisation programme, reports BSS.

In reply to a question from Rashid Khan Menon (WP) he said that the mills are: Bangladesh Textile Mills Ltd with its market price fixed at minus Tk 419.60 lakh after deducting debts and liabilities from its total fixed and current assets, Barisal Textile Mills at Tk 343.87 lakh, Kishoreganj Textile Mills at Tk 1509.46 lakh, Kohinoor Spinning Mills at Tk 1261.00 lakh, Khulna Textile Mills at 238.28 lakh, Madaripur Textile Mills at minus Tk 130.30 lakh, Noakhali Textile Mills at Tk 389.49 lakh, Sharmin Textile Mills at minus Tk 266.74 lakh, Dhaka Textile Mills at Tk 273.20 lakh and Josephine Fabrics Ltd at Tk 198.88 lakh.

The State Minister for Textiles in reply to another question from Advocate Abdul Matin Khushru (AL-Comilla) said that eight textile mills under the BTMC and 21 mills under private ownership were now having lay-offs.

He said that these mills are: Madaripur Textile Mills, Bangladesh Textile Mills Ltd, Noakhali Textile Mills, Sharmin Textile Mills, Barisal Textile Mills, Kishoreganj Textile Mills, Kohinoor Spinning Mills, Khulna Textile Mills, Madaripur Textile Mills, Noakhali Textile Mills, Dhaka Textile Mills, Josephine Fabrics Ltd, Armin Silk Industries Ltd., Shah Mokhdum Textile Mills Ltd., Silco Textile Mills Ltd., Lawrence Textile (Private) Ltd., Cosmos Textile, Gokul Textile Mills, Messrs PICWIC Textile, Ananya Textile Mills, Mandal Textile Mills, Jamal Textile, Uttar Silk Mills, Bogra Cotton Spinning Mills Ltd., Janata Textile, Asiatic Cotton Mills Ltd. and Roni Textile Mills Ltd., under private ownership.

He also said that Halima Textile Mills at Comilla had declared lay-off on 24 January 1986. The mill authorities had taken steps to reopen the mill.

## Amendment to labour laws suggested

Minister for Labour and Manpower Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan yesterday stressed the need for strengthening the system of inspection of mills, factories and enterprises to safeguard the interests of the workers, report BSS.

The minister was addressing the officials in the office of the chief inspector of mills and establishments held here at the Labour Office. Presided over by Tozammel Hossain, chief inspector of mills and establishments, the meeting was addressed, among others, by Humayun Shamsul Kabir, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Labour and Manpower and Dr Ruhul Quddus, deputy chief inspector, directorate of the mills and establishments.

The minister reminded everyone that the directorate was created to ensure the welfare of the workers and asked all concerned to work with honesty and devotion. Any failure would have to be borne by all, he cautioned.

The Labour Minister emphasised the need for developing the professional skills of the officials and called upon them to be earnest in restoring the good name of the directorate. He also advised them to treat workers as friends.

Stressing the need for necessary amendment and reform to the existing labour laws, the minister said the government had already formed a commission on labour law. He directed the officials of the directorate to prepare recommendations on labour and send them to the ministry.

Earlier the chief inspector of mills and establishments gave an account of the activities of the directorate.

## Huda attends plenary session of Vienna confce

The Information Minister, Barrister Nazmul Huda attended the 13th session of the plenary of the world conference on human rights now being held in Vienna, accordingly to a message received in Dhaka yesterday, reports BSS.

He participated in the session dedicated specially to the rights of the child on Monday, June 21. The Prime Minister of Nepal was among the leading dignitaries who addressed the session.

During his stay here, the Information Minister called on the Prime Minister of Nepal, Girija Prasad Koirala, and conveyed the greetings of Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia.
