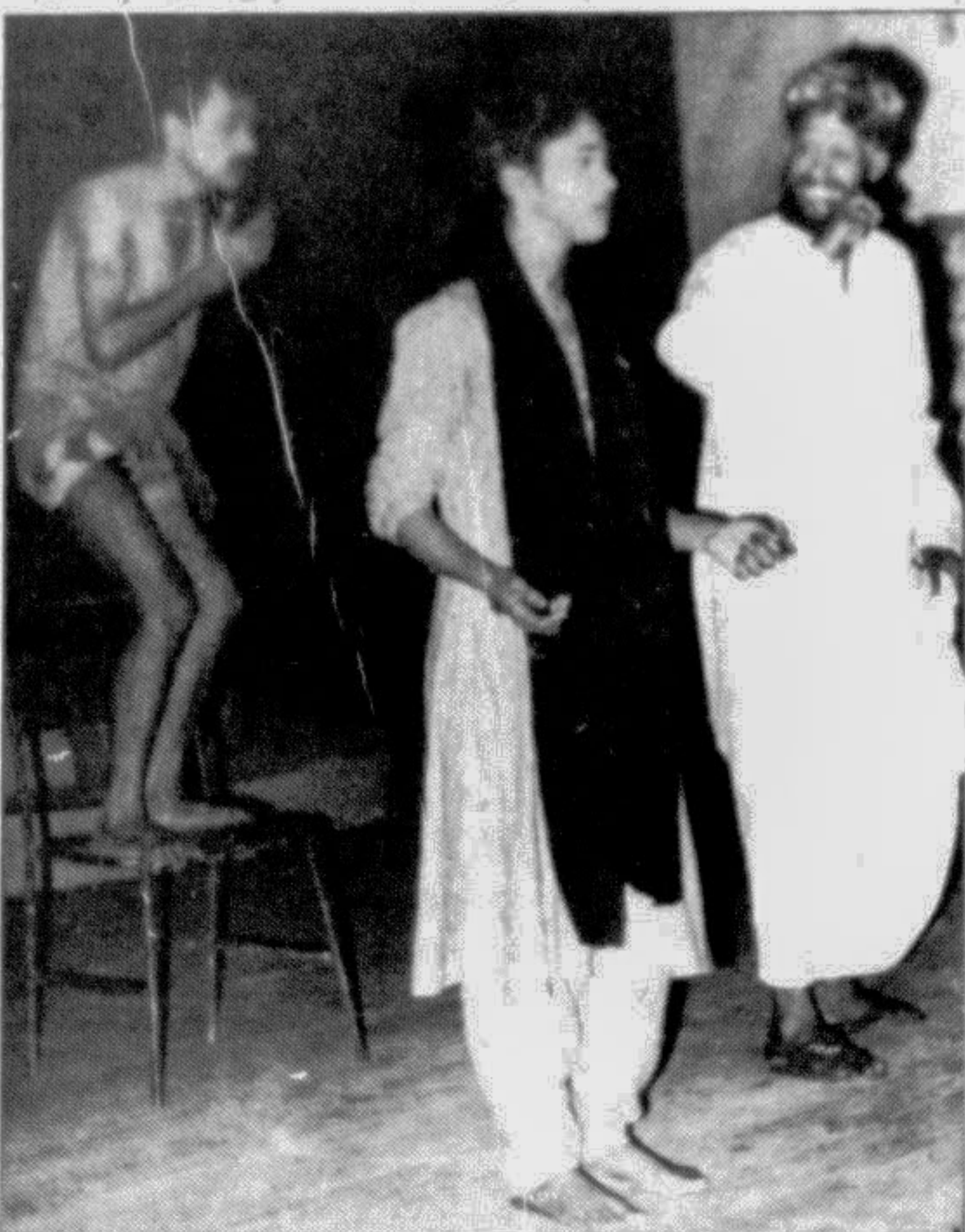

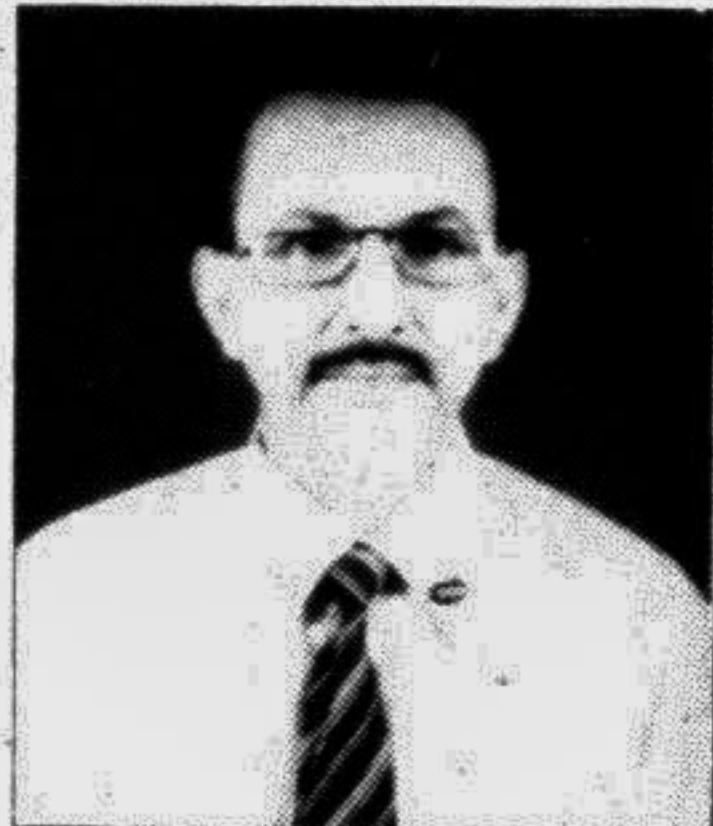

WASA asked to reduce system loss

The WASA Chairman informed the meeting that the system loss would be further reduced to 46 per cent by the end of this month.

Among the members of the committee, Deputy Minister for LGRD and Cooperatives Abdul Hye, MPs of BNP Ukil A Sattar and Samsuddin Ahmed, Awami League's Abdur Razzak, Hazi Rashid Mosharrar and Munsur Ahmed attended the meeting. Secretary of Local Government Division Mushiqur Rahman and Secretary of Rural Development and Cooperatives Division Md Mahe Alam were also present.

11 lakh metric tons food grains in reserve

The 15th meeting of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Food Ministry yesterday discussed the overall food situation in the country, reports BSS.

Food Minister M Shamsul Islam, who is also the chairman of the committee, presided over the meeting held at the Jatiya Sangsad Bhaban in Dhaka.

The meeting observed that the overall food situation was satisfactory with a total stock of 11 lakh metric ton food-grains.

The internal procurement position of Irri-Boro and distribution of foodgrains also came up for discussion.

To ensure fair price to the farmers, the meeting recommended to expedite the internal procurement of Irri-Boro which started from May 15 last, and side by side export the fine variety of rice.

The meeting disclosed that a total of 1240 officers and staff of food department have applied for voluntary retirement. Of them, a total number of 1002 persons have gone in retirement on voluntary basis.

The meeting pressed for early recovery of outstanding dues of the Food Ministry from other government organisations and millers.

The members of the committee who attended the meeting were M A Matin (BNP), Mosharrar Hossain (AL), Salahuddin Qamran (BNP), Mirza Azam (AL) and Azizur Rahman Chowdhury (Jamaat).
