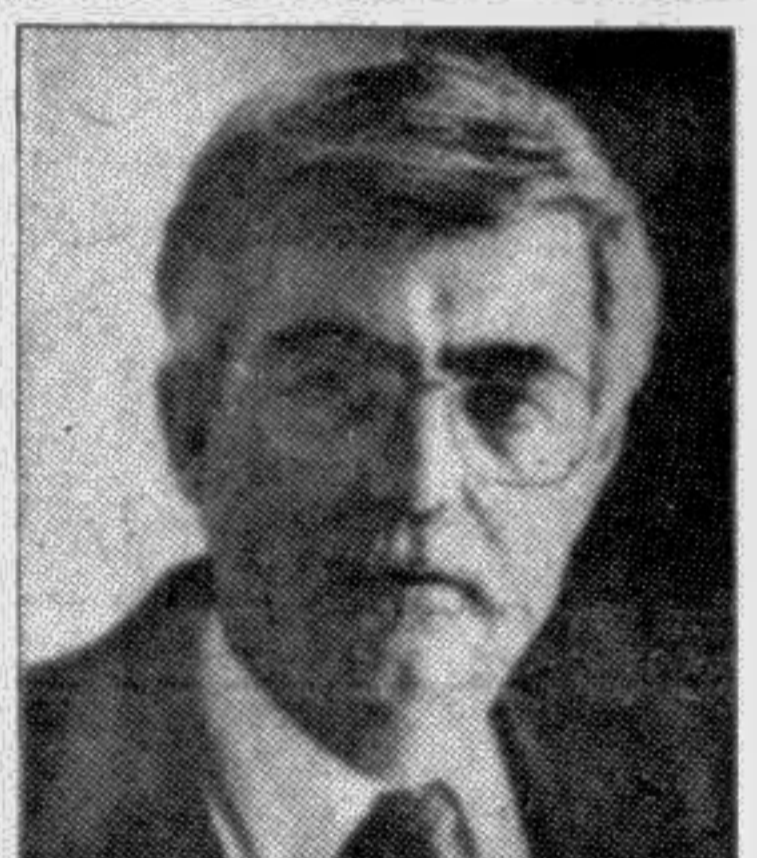
Ahsan Habib's anniversary of death today
