## Forest administration to be recast: Noman

Minister for Environment, Forest, Fisheries and Livestock Abdullah Al Noman said here yesterday that the forest administration, which was developed for the preservation and management of forest resources, was not sufficient to cope with the present need, reports BSS.

He was addressing as chief guest the biennial conference of the Bangladesh Diploma Foresters Association.

The minister stressed the need for recasting the forest administration.

He said that social forestry was getting momentum day-by-day with the gradual decrease of natural forest due to ever-increasing pressure of population. The present concept of for-

est administration is being changed, he added.

Referring to the personal interest of Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia, Noman said that her appeal to the people for plantation has created a social movement during last two years. He said that 25 per cent of our total land may be brought under tree cover within twenty years if the present tempo in social afforestation continues.
