The minister said a special parliamentary probe committee had been constituted to investigate the so-called corruptions as the government believed in transparent and accountable running of affairs and was not involved in any corruption. The Information Minister expressed the hope that in course of the investigation the image of the government would become brighter and the evil design of the opposition would be un-


