Tommy's dishes break class barriers in UK

Tommy Miah is an enterprising Bangladeshi who has been currying favour in the culinary world in Britain where he is known as the Curry King, re-

ports UNB. The 34-year-old Bangladeshi-born restaurateur has become renowned for his mouthwatering spicy Asian dishes whose popularity breaks social and class barriers in Britain.

From poor to rich, busi nessmen to executives, politicians to scholars including British Prime Minister John Major — everyone who is anyone is fond of Tommy Miah's dishes. The vivid example of his popularity is "Tommy Miah's Curry Club" which boasts members from the field of politics, business, showbiz, etc.

Son of a factory engineer from Sylhet, Tommy never aspired to become a restauratuer "But I had interest in food and cooking when I was a boy of 12. I first learnt cooking from my

Eventually, Tommy's interest took him to Queen Margaret's Catering College in London where he studied cooking and catering before taking up a career in restaurant business.

With help from his family in 1978, Tommy set up his first venture — a little takeway shop in Birmingham. But he soon moved to Edinburgh where in 1980 he set up his first restaurant "Verandah".

His business prospered and he moved on to his next venture - opening The Raj Restaurant, a stylish restaurant in Edinburgh that quickly became popular for spicy Asian food.

Tommy now owns a chain of restaurants in Scotland. But despite his growing business preoccupations, cooking (alongwith football and social work) remained Tommy's hobby. He adapts dishes from his Bangladesh homeland to

European cookery, and vice versa, placing great emphasis on the cross-fertilisation of cuisines.

Of late, marketing and public relations for Asian food has become one of his main preoccupations. Tommy is also concentrating much of his efforts on promotional events and social works like charity fund-

Tommy is in the process of completing a manufacturing plant in Scotland for Asian food Due to be commissioned later this year, it will be an "innovation". Besides producing quality range of Asian foods for supply to the major European supermarket chains, the huge project will also create

His latest venture is "The Bangladesh Festival of Food and Culture," which will run as a fringe event to the coming Edinburgh International Festival

As a prelude to the festival, Tommy has also organised a cooking competition in Bangladesh, to be held November/December this year. There will be 20 contestants and the winner will later travel to Edinburgh to join the Asian Chef of the Year competition during the International Festival.

Tommy published his first cookbook, "The Best of Bangladesh", which was a hit with the general public as well as lovers of Asian food. His second book, "The Secrets of Asian Masterchefs", is being officially launched in Bangladesh today (Monday).

A keen social worker, Tommy also featured in Desmond Wilcox's BBC TV Programme "The Visit," which highlighted his work for an orphanage in Dhaka. He raised funds for it from the sales of "The Best of Bangladesh."
