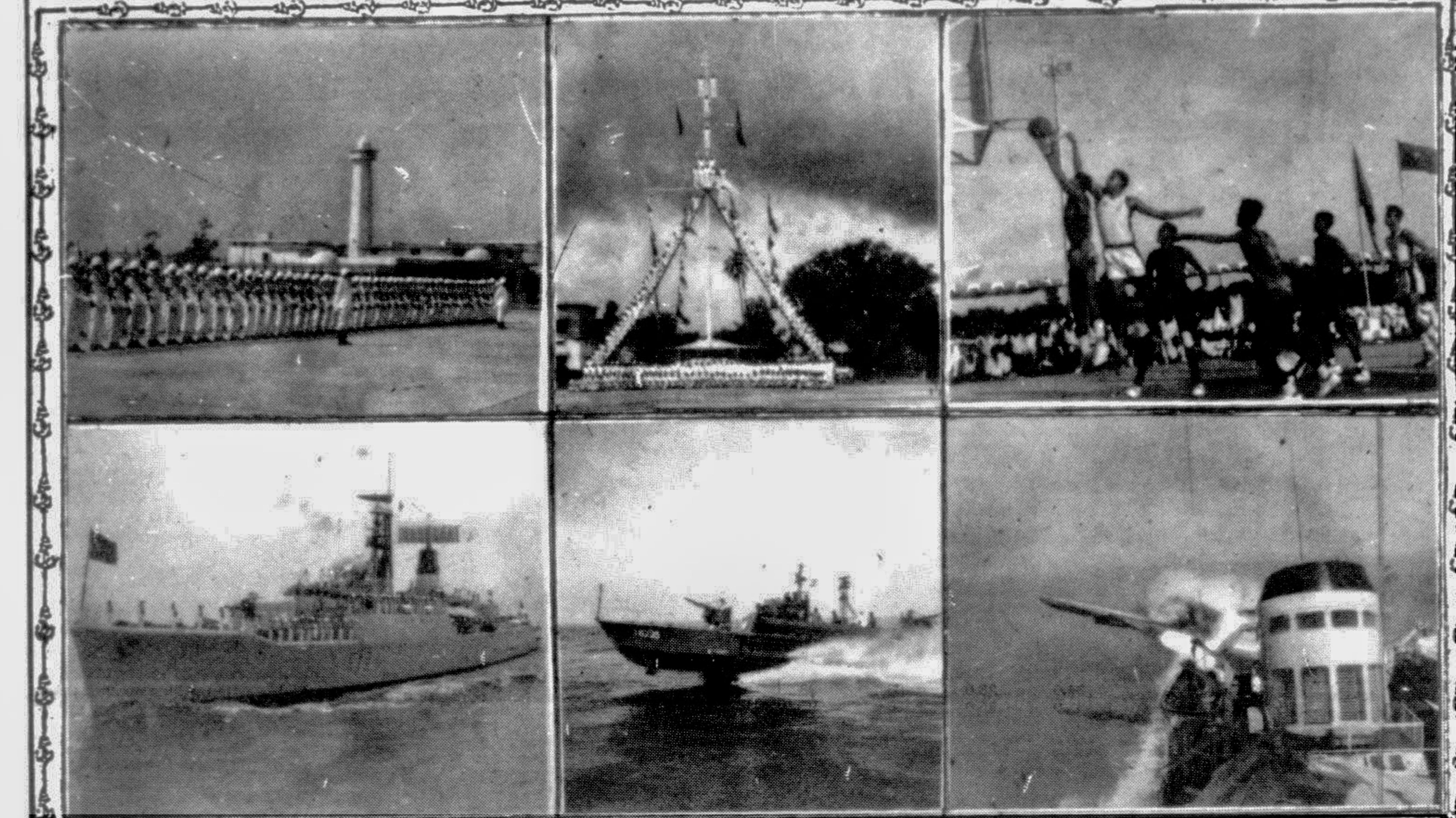
Air Chief back home

 গ) ওজন-৫০ কেঞ্জি (কমপক্ষে)
 ঘ) চোখের দৃষ্টি-৬/৬
- ৩। **শিক্ষাগত ও কারিগরী যোগ্যতা :**
 ক) শিক্ষাগত :
