'Developing states should have political unity'

Developing countries of the South facing the curse of poverty should have political and economic unity, and pursue self-reliant development with a view to having a better deal in the conflict with the North for control over their treasure of biological diversity, says a press release.

Conflict between the North and the South has replaced the cold war and will dominate international relations in the coming decades, the International Workshop on Environment and Poverty was told by Paul Rogers, Professor of Peace Studies, University of Bradford, UK, yesterday.

The three-day workshop, organised by the Global Forum on Environment and Poverty was inaugurated here Thursday by Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia who is also the Chairperson of the South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC).

Leading thinkers on poverty and environment from 25 countries, now attending the workshop, are having deliberations to establish linkages between poverty and environment, identifying elements of a poverty convention and an agenda for action.

There is lack of security at home, as well as outside. There is no security in the society nor in the state as well, she said and added that in most cases women and the children were the primary victims of any riot, war or conflict.

Sufia Kamal was presiding over the inaugural function of the South Asian Convention of the People's Plan for 21st Century (PP-21) held at the Academy of Planning and Development yesterday morning.

Chief Whip of the Parliament Khandaker Delwar Hossain said Bangladesh is a glorious example of communal harmony. People of all religions were enjoying equal rights here in all respects.

formed together with 11 joint convenors and 101 members. An advisory committee consisting of 51 eminent advocates and personalities of the country was also formed in the meeting.

Radio Journalists Welfare Assoc Radio Journalists Welfare Association Thursday expressed resentment over the daily-daily practice of authorities in solving various problems of radio journalists including pending promotion.

At a meeting of the association at the National Broadcasting House the association leaders observed that many officials were suffering from total frustration as they remained in the same posts for 15 to 20 years without any promotion.

Seminar on afforestation Global ecology at stake

KHULNA, July 23: A two-day seminar on "Coastal Resources Development, Afforestation and Shrimp Cultivation" began at the Khulna University today, reports UNB.

Mayor of Khulna City Corporation Sheikh Tabebar Rahman inaugurated the seminar, organised jointly by Khulna University and the National Geography Society of Bangladesh. Vice-Chancellor of Khulna University Prof Abdul Hamid and Secretary General of Geography Society Mirza Moziduddin were among those who spoke at the inaugural session.

The speakers emphasised on united efforts in combating the growing deterioration of environment, saying that overall global ecology was at stake and the situation in Bangladesh also took a serious turn with the population boom.

They also stressed the need for creation of more forests by planting trees in greater number and adoption of scientific method in shrimp cultivation in the coastal region for greater per acre yield.

Nearly 100 scientists and experts in the field of fishery, forestry and geography from home and abroad, including 10 women, were participating in the seminar.
