BDRCS relief to be sent to flood-hit areas

Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS) at an emergency meeting Saturday decided to send relief materials for the flood affected people of 22 districts of the country.

The districts are: Kurigram, Lalmonirhat, Gaibandha, Panchagarh, Rangpur, Sirajganj, Jamalpur, Sylhet, Moulvibazar, Sherpur, Sunamganj, Feni, Cox's Bazar, Nilphamari, Chittagong, Khagrachhari, Bandarban, Comilla, Thakurgaon, Ranggamati, Netrokona and Habiganj.

The relief materials will comprising rice, pulses, sarcoles, lungis, medicines and emergency food.

The meeting, presided over by the society's Chairman Syed Shahidul Haque Jamal, MP, was attended by the members of the managing board.

The meeting also decided to open control room at the areas to monitor the flood situation and relief works.

Anti-autocracy movement cases may be reviewed

Jail reform, Anti-Terrorism Law and withdrawal of political cases related to the anti-autocracy movement were discussed at the 12th meeting of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Home Ministry yesterday, reports UNB.

Chaired by Home Minister Abdul Matin Chowdhury, the meeting at the Sangsad Bhaban also discussed other issues like narcotics control, security of shrimp cultivation, gambling and illegal lottery.

A detailed report, including the recommendations of Justice F K M A Munim Jail Reform Commission 1978 on jail problems and jail reform, was presented in the meeting which emphasised discussion on the report before taking any proposal.

Proper, lawful and neutral execution of Anti-Terrorism Law was stressed in the meeting. It was informed that terrorism and violence reduced rapidly after enactment of the law. The Committee proposed to take proper precautions and vigilance in administering the law.

The meeting was informed that the withdrawal and remission of political cases related to the anti-autocracy movement were being considered in accordance with the provisions of law.

The meeting stressed the need for taking strong measure to maintain law and order, and curb dacoity in shrimp cultivation areas. It was told that already some big gangs of dacoits were nabbed and more Ansars were deployed in the said areas.

It also proposed to take stringent actions against drug trafficking and abuses, illegal lottery and gambling.

Committee members Whip Mahubul Alam Tara, Abdur Rauf Chowdhury, Shahjahan Chowdhury and A Y M Khalidur Rahman of BNP, Mohammed Rahmat Ali and Abul Hasanat Abdullah of Awami League, and Mattur Rahman Nazami of Jamaat-e-Islami took part in the discussion.

169 held under various charges

Police rounded up 169 people, including 11 wanted criminals, from different parts of the city yesterday, reports UNB.

The arrested also include three under the Anti-Terrorism Act, eight under the Special Powers Act, one for dacoity, two for robbery, two accused of kidnapping, six of burglary and another six of stealing.
