

Call to declare Sylhet flood-hit areas 'disaster areas'

Sylhet Bibhag Andalan, Dhaka at a rally Tuesday demanded declaration of the flood affected areas of greater Sylhet as 'disaster areas' and formation of a national relief committee headed by the Prime Minister.

Speakers at the rally also called for a permanent solution to the recurring flood problem in the Sylhet region, while noting that this was the fifth time the region was hit.

The committee formed earlier by the Andalan to provide relief in the affected areas will continue to work. The committee will also collect relief materials at its 881 Shahidbag office from 4 to 7 pm everyday.

The rally was attended by Advocate Abdur Raja, Ershaduddin Ahmed, Shawkat Ali Afzal, Mahiuddin Ahmed and others.

Late Akramuzzaman was the brother-in-law of Foreign Minister A S M Mostafizur Rahman. He married the eldest sister of Mostafiz.

The name-e-janaza for the deceased will be held at Baitul Mukarram National Mosque tomorrow after Zohr prayers. He will be buried at Banani graveyard.

His qukhwan will be held at the official residence of the Foreign Minister at Eskaton garden after Asr prayers on August 1.

Begum Syeda Khatoun, wife of late Abdul Hamid Chowdhury, died of protracted illness at her Kumarpura Jhannarpar residence, Sylhet on the night following Sunday. She was 68, reports BSS.

Her eldest daughter is BNP leader, Begum Fatema Chowdhury Paru, MP, and eldest son is eminent freedom fighter Yamin Chowdhury (Bir Bikram). The deceased is also survived by four other sons and three daughters.

Agri rehabilitation programme in flood-hit areas to be taken

An agriculture rehabilitation programme will be taken soon on priority basis for the farmers of flood affected areas of the country, reports BSS.

This was discussed at the 11th Parliamentary Standing Committee meeting of the Ministry of Agriculture at Sangsodhaban yesterday with Agriculture, Irrigation, Water Development and Flood Control Minister M Majid-ul-Haq in the chair.

The meeting agreed to take the agriculture rehabilitation programme for the farmers of the north eastern and south eastern districts of the country after completion of survey of actual damages of various crops of current season.

The meeting expressed anxiety on the present market price of fertilizer and its irregular distribution system. The agriculture minister said the price of fertilizer had reduced by Tk 650 per ton.

He requested the members of the committee to investigate the market during the visit to their respective constituencies and inform to the concern authority if they found any irregularity in fertilizer selling.

The meeting also expressed satisfaction on the recent decision taken by the cabinet regarding the proposal of agriculture ministry on fixing up the actual prices of agricultural produces. It was informed that a training course of block supervisors of agriculture extension departments had started from this month to enhance their activities. Under the programme five thousands block supervisor will be trained in two years by technical training board.

Members of the committee Hajj Abdul Mazid Talukder, Md Shahidul Islam, Md Alamgir Kabir and Mamaching of BNP, Md Azharul Islam and Anwarul Islam of Awami League, Gazi Nazrul Islam of Jamaat-e-Islami and Agriculture Secretary A N M Eusuf were present in the meeting.

117 arrested on various charges

Four killed in separate incidents

Four persons including a minor boy were killed in separate incidents in and outside the city Monday.

A 10-year-old boy was crushed under the wheels of a speeding truck at Bara Majlish in Sonargaon Monday morning.

In another accident, Bachchu, 45, died on the spot when a bus ran over him at Aminbazar, at the outskirts of the city.

Al. Gazaria, Munahiganj, Hashem, 35, was dashed to the ground by a speeding bus at 12:55 am. He succumbed to his injuries at the DMCH.

Meanwhile, Amanullah, 32, a scavenger reportedly committed suicide by hanging himself from a branch of a tree in the early hours of Monday.

Police recover stolen tubelights

Gulshan police led by a magistrate of Dhaka City Corporation (DCC) Monday recovered stolen tubelights and chock coil of the DCC from three shops at Badda vegetable market, reports BSS.

In the absence of the shopkeepers three employees of the shops were given to the custody of the Gulshan police station for interrogation.

The DCC recently announced an award of Tk 15,000 to help apprehend the sellers, users and purchasers of tubelights, chokes coil and sodium lights with DCC mark and Tk 5000 for providing correct information in this regard.
