**Tk 60 cr Biman housing complex near ZIA**

A housing complex for the employees of Biman Bangladesh Airlines will be built at a cost of about Tk 60 crore near Zia International Airport (ZIA), says a press release. State Minister for Civil Aviation and Tourism Abdul Mannan laid the foundation stone of the housing complex yesterday at the project site. Secretary, Ministry of Civil Aviation and Tourism Afaalur Rahman, Biman's Managing Director Abdul Mueyed Chowdhury, Chairman, Civil Aviation Authority Air Commodore Shamsheer Ali were present.

The project will be built on an area of 15 acres of land leased from CAAB which will accommodate 760 furnished flats in 76 five-storied buildings. The project will be completed in three phases in 6-years. Civic amenities like schools, playgrounds, and community centre will also feature in this modern housing complex.

President Biswas was exchanging views with Weerasinghe Mallimaratchi, Minister for Food, Cooperatives and Janasaviya of Sri Lanka when the latter called on him at Banghababan.

He said the government had introduced free market economy, privatisation of industries and liberalization of industrial policy to encourage foreign investment in the country.

the foreign investors, he added.

The Shri Lankan minister mentioned with gratitude the condolence and the deep sympathy expressed by President Biswas at the assassination of President Premadasa and the visit of Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia, who is also the Chairperson of the SAARC, to Colombo for attending the funeral of the late President.
