

She would have been dead by now, but for the Rotary Club of Dhaka Buriganga. The club adopted her as an appropriate case for community service and went all they way to see that she virtually triumphed over the jaws of death. It mobilised funds for her treatment and then arranged her surgery at the Bangladesh Institute of Cardio Vascular Disease. Professor Nabi Alam Khan, a surgeon of great repute, repaired her valve. Mahfuza is now back to her daily chore as a normal human being. She is planning to marry now to consummate her fuller

Mahfuza was not the solitary example of humanitarian help. Fired by a spirit of altruism, the club organised financial assistance and logistics for the treatment of two more girls. One of them, Ruksana Parveen Mukti, had her valves replaced following two major time-consuming and expensive surg-eries. The third girl, Lucky Akher, had a much more complicated ailment. The club arranged to take her to the Birla Heart Centre in Calcutta, where doctors said she was suffering from juvenile arteritis, a rare disease with a very a low rate of

survival. Her treatment had been successfully coordinated and, if all goes well, she may undergo surgery at the Birla some time in August.

Saving a life is worth millions of charity. It is a mission synonymous with the Rotary Club of Dhaka Buriganga. This was the spirit which had pro-pelled a group of 14 Rotarians into founding this club five years ago. At least eight of them were old Rotarians with rich experiegce in the four avenues of services of this great international organisation. Others were new but imbued with the ideals of Rotary.

There are now more than 2.000 Rotarians all over Bangladesh. But the Rotary Club of Dhaka Buriganga represents a group of like-minded people drawn from various professions. Fellowship and an urge to help the suffering humanity have since been the hallmark of this club.

The club's journey had actually begun on 27 April, 1988, when this group first met to decide on how to bring it about. There was a bit of initial flexibility in fixing the name. It was first thought that Rotary Club of Dhaka Rajdhani should be the most appropriate one. It spawned some subsequent internal problems. So, the members decided to finally accept Rotary Club of Dhaka Buriganga as the name.

The Rotary International awarded the charter to the club on 27 June, 1988. Ever since, the Club has played its effective role in the District 3280. Today, with 40 members on its roll, it prides itself as one of he highprofile clubs in the country.

Rotary is known as the world's first service club. The first club, the Rotary Club of

Chicago, Illinois, came into being in 1905 with its founder, Paul Percy Harris, and three of his other friends as members.

Rotary today has flourished beyond all frontiers. It is now an organisation of more than 1.16 million business and professional men and women united worldwide. Its main task is to provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations, and help build good will and peace in the world. Rotary international is the association of more

than 26,000 clubs worldwide. The idea behind this voluntary pursuit is to bring the various nations closer through participation in Rotary's international humanitarian and exchange programmes. Through Youth Exchange, Rotary Foundation Ambassedorial Scholarships, Group Study Exchanges of professionals, and other programmes, thousands each year travel to other countries as ambassadors of goodwill under the auspices of Rotary Inter-

Rotary Clubs meet weekly to build friendships and discuss service goals. Membership is by invitation and is on the basis of one representative from each type of business, profession and institution to ensure a cross section of community leader-

Rotary Club of Dhaka Buriganga's strong point is the community service and the cultivation of fellowship and international understanding and men and women of all shades and persuasion.


The Club donated Tk 100,000 to BIRDEM to help them set up a new Blood Transfusion Centre in Dhaka. Once established, it is expected to be a unique centre of its

kind. It also donated more than Tk 500,000 for constructing a primary school cum-cyclone relief centre in Sitakund in Chittagong. This centre would enable hundreds of people to take temporary shelter in it should they ever hear of severe cyclone or tidal wave about to hit their coast.

Another community service project of the club will emerge in the Angorpota-Dahagram en-clave for the 12,500 people who have lived in that five sq km of area without much knowing their national identity. As it was a forbidden land for nearly 40 years, the area has no schools, medical centres, markets, post offices or police stations. The Dhaka Buriganga Rotarians have committed themselves to helping them in as many ways as possible. This is going to be the club's state-of-the-art com-

The club has also made a laudable efforts to seek international fellowship. It won the first prize of the District for its contribution to the Rotary Foundation. It was the only club from Bangladesh to respond to a call by Rotary International President Cliff Dochterman to contribute to a special fund for the refugees of Hosnia-Herzegovina, the victims of a brutal attack by Serbs. Cliff has recognised the contribution through a personal letter of appreciation.

As it enters the sixth year, the club's plate is full on community and vocational services. its flag of quality and consistency will continue to flutter, in order to translate into reality the new theme "Believe in what you do: Do what you believe in' propounded by the New R I President Robert Barth. The Rotary Club of Dhaka Buriganga is in for another glorious year of Rotary.




