BSF kills Bangladeshi

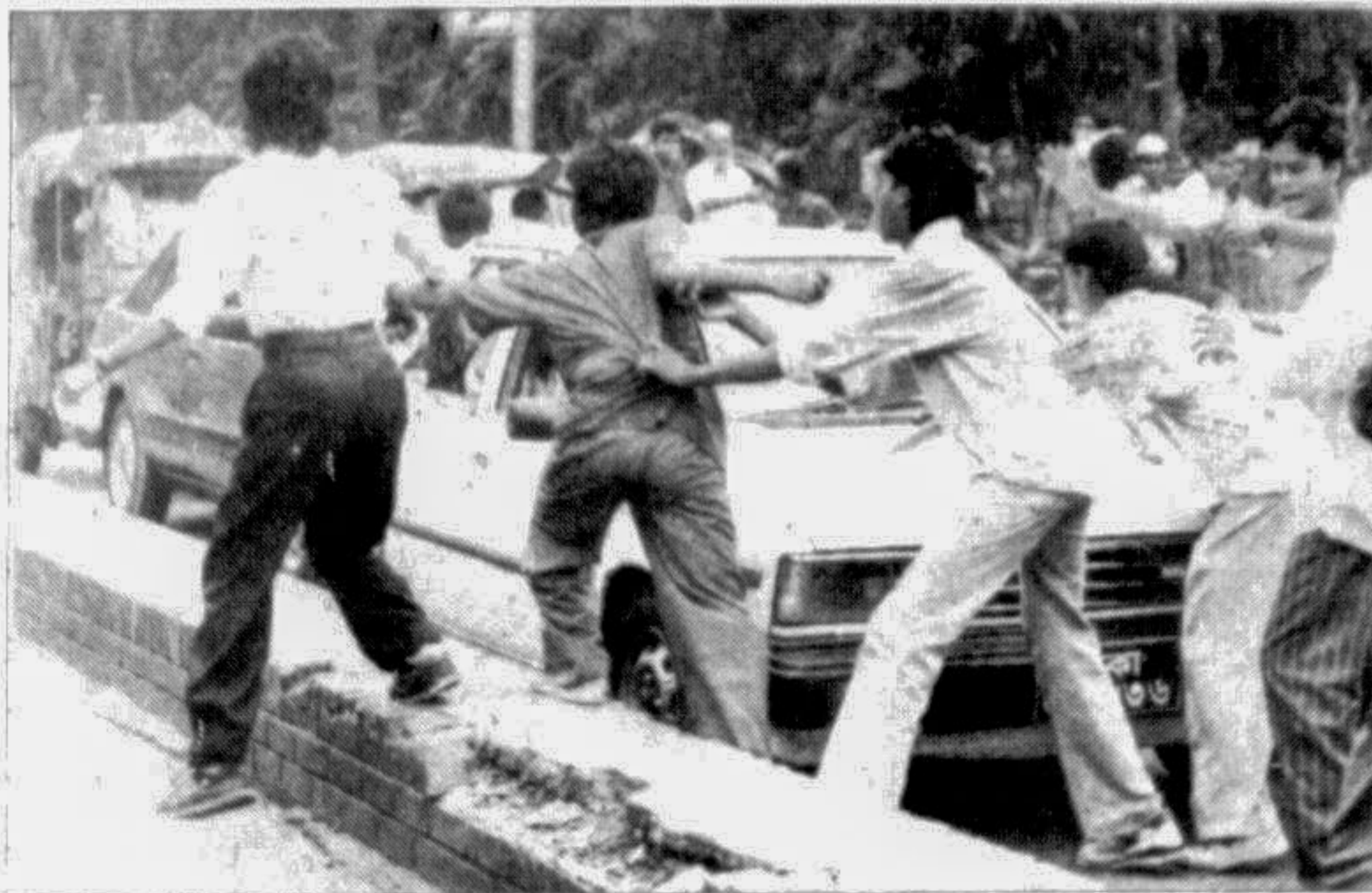
