Voice of the Children

'Shishu Katha' (Voice of the Children) is a quarterly newsletter written by destitute children. It might be a bit confusing to many but the four member editorial board of Shishu Katha is drawn from children of UCEP (Underprivileged Children's Education Programme), TDH (Traders Home Switzerland) and BNPS (Bangladesh Nari Progoti Sangha). The main objective of this special newsletter is to establish greater communication between children and allow the disadvantaged children to speak for themselves.

These children are deprived of the basic needs of life, - health, wealth and education. They are born and brought up in over crowded alleys or streets where the word 'education' is as alien as 'sanitation' or any other basic needs of life. Every day they wake up not knowing whether they will get any breakfast or not. A strange way for a child to begin a new day but that is the reality.

Shishu Katha is a newsletter through which the children can express their hidden fantasies, desires and imagine their future plans, if ever they get a chance to be educated. But among them there are a few determined children who have made it a point to go to school, inspite of all the odds. These young kids, hardly 8 to 12 years old, have to earn their living support themselves and continue school. Many of their dreams do not materialise when tuition fees can no longer be managed but a few strong ones fight out ways to meet this challenge.

Iskander of TDH, Hena, Shefalt of UC-EP, Al Islam of Model School who are on the editorial board of Shishu Katha are few such examples. Inspite of their struggles and burdens they are determined to make their dreams come

To be on the board a child has to be a benefictary of an NGO's and their contract is for a year, so that other children can also get chance to express themselves. The name of the newsletter, the theme of the issue, selection of articles including reporting, writing and editing, are all done by the editorial board. Expect for publication, the elders have a very negligible part in the newsletter. The children are therefore free to express themselves. This newsletter is distributed among schools, free of cost. The children write articles and also letters expressing their dreams.

Their August '93 issue is about children who lost their jobs because of the government's bill where children under 15 cannot work in any factory. In this issue they try to talk to children who lost their jobs and as a result cannot help their families anymore. Al Islam has three elder sisters working in a garments factory, the eldest supports his education, but now they have all lost

My father is a rickshaw puller but his earnings are not enough for our family. Our family is very big. have to educate myself and be established, so I have to study no matter how hard it becomes for me." This is what Al Islam, a ten year boy writes in an article called 'Jiban Sangram' (Struggle for Survival). His thoughts are haphazard but the message is quite straight forward. Iskander in his heart rendering article on observing May Day states that a hungry child works to support his family and himself not out of a mere whim and instead of banning their right to work, the state should undertake policies to improve the working conditions for children. If the government insists on banning child labour then it must ensure,

food, education and shelter for those children. This was Iskander's and many other children's de mand on the historic May Day. Imrul Kabir of Jhenidah, a student of class ten, and also a trade unionist, wrote a letter to Shishu Katha's editorial board thanking Iskander's plea to the Prime Minister, leaders of opposition and other trade unionists. A child works more hours than the elders but on low wages Their labour is cheated and not properly recognized. A sick child, not going to work one day might find himself out of work the next day, writes Anwar Hossain another child. Who should there be such cruel deals for a mere child of ten years. a class III student of Model School, is an example of such a problem. His mother died when he was five and father died a year after. He has no one to support him, he works as an apprentice in an automobile workshop where he earns Tk.300 a month. With this money he bears the expenses of his education. But unfortunately his working hours collide with his school timing. What can a mere child do in such circumstances?

Somehow these kids are strong, they survive inspite of all the odds. But the question remains whether their survival can be termed as living. With no education how can they carry on and rise above the sub-human existence?

Shishu Katha was first published on December '92 on behalf of Radda Barnen by Saleem Samad of Development Features. It has a circulation of 20,000 and goes everywhere in Bangladesh Natore, Jhenidah, Demra, just name a place.

The children are very enthusiastic about this newsletter, and one of Al Islam's friends commented "I also want to be a journalist, can you help me become one ?" Well it is very encouraging to know that in the future we will have such


