'Decisions on child rights yet to be materialised

Speakers at a seminar yesterday alleged that the national and international decisions taken on children's rights were yet to be materialised.

The two-day seminar on 'Child Rights in Bangladesh' held at the children's auditorium of the National Museum, was organised by the Central Khelaghar Asar, a voluntary organisation.

Sardar Fazlul Karim, Director of the Publication Wing of the Dhaka University, describing the situation of the average child in the country said societies in which a child had to die of malnutrition were in fact civilised.

The Chairman of the Atomic Energy Commission, Engineer M A Quyum said not too long ago a large consignment of highly radioactive powder milk was imported, but its entry into the country was successfully blocked.

Kalim Sharafi, an noted singer of Tagore songs, said since children are the country's future, their rights have to be upheld.

The key-note paper was presented by the Chairman of the Khelaghar Asar Professor Ali Asgar while Kalim Sharafi presided over the function.

The closing session of the seminar will begin at the same venue at 5 pm today.

Tributes paid to Kader Sardar

Tributes were paid to the memory of Mirza Abdul Kader Sardar, popularly known as Kader Sardar, the last President of traditional Panchayat system of Dhaka, at a discussion on his 31st death anniversary held under the auspices of Dhaka Samity at BCIC auditorium here, reports BSS.

Speaking on the occasion Deputy Leader of the House Prof AQM Badruddoza Chowdhury, who had a personal association with Kader Sardar, said although he had no institutional education, Sardar had a high political aptitude and wisdom and he played a significant role during the political and social transition of his age. But his identity would be written in the history mainly as a pioneer of social progress who dedicated his life for the betterment of the backward Muslim community of Dhaka, he said.

Sex-victim threatened for seeking justice
