Fake factories unearthed

Spurious oil and ball-point pen factories were found by Detective Branch police in separate raids in the city in the last 48 hours ending yesterday. Police also arrested 13 persons under forgery laws.

In the two-day long raid on Monday and Tuesday, police found a factory that produced fake ball-point pens under the brandname 'G Q Econo' and 'Writer'. Two workers at the site were also arrested.

From Maulavibazar — country's whole-sale depot — police recovered huge amount of adulterated ghee, soyabean oil, butter oil and arrested four persons.

Another five dealing in adulterated ghee were arrested from Mirpur Section 11 by police.
