## IIRO distributes relief goods in Chittagong

CHITTAGONG, Sept 3: International Islamic Relief Organisation (IIRO) has started distribution of huge quantities of relief materials worth Taka 11,87,829 among 3250 flood affected families of three police stations of the district here, reported UNB.

The three police stations selected for relief works are Raniganj, Satkania and Anowara disclosing this at a press conference at a hotel here today. IIRO social welfare director Taufiq Muhammad Alt said that the relief materials included 10,500 kg of fertilizers, house building materials worth Taka 4,36,714, medicines worth Taka 86,806, rice 7,400 kg, 2100 kg of pulses and clothes worth Taka 29,506.

Taufiq said that the three police stations had been selected for carrying on relief works on the basis of reports of prominent people of the locality as well as their visit to the areas.

Satkania, Raniganj and Anowara thanas were worst affected areas during the recent flood.

The IIRO director said that his organisation was running three medical centres at Anowara, Banskhali and Sandwip and that some more will be opened in other flood affected areas in the future.

He said that IIRO established in 1986 in Jeddah, Saudi Ara-

bia had a network of relief activities in 86 Muslim and non-Muslim countries. IIRO has also been carrying on massive relief works among Rohingya refugees in Cox's Bazar, he added.

Elhado Abu Noor, director finance and Dr Tossun Ahmad, director health services — IIRO were also present at the press conference.


