Cooperative assocs to provide Tk 1.8cr to rural poor

One hundred thirty-nine assetless thana central cooperative associations will provide Tk 1.85 crore for socio-economic development of the rural poor from their own fund, reports BSS.
This was disclosed in the two-day workshop of the Bangladesh Rural Development Board (BRDB) RD-12 project held on September, 4 and 5 at Pali Bhaban at Kauran Bazar in Dhaka.
Director General BRDB, Syed Marghubur Rahman inaugurated the workshop which was jointly organised by the BRDB, RD-12 project and Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA).
Inaugurating the workshop the director general, urged the participants to improve and strengthen their skill and ability by availing training facilities extended to them by RD-12 project to generate more income for building a self-reliant rural economy.
The project, being implemented with the financial assistance of CIDA, is aimed at alleviating poverty of the rural poor by organising cooperative societies in 17 districts under the project.
At present 15834 primary cooperative societies have been

formed and 3.92 lakh members deposited Tk 12.97 crore as their small savings. Taka 87.89 crore has been disbursed as credit amongst rural poor to raise their income and thereby improve their quality of life. The credit realisation percentage is 91 per cent.

The main objective of the project is to assist assetless rural men and women by providing them with training and credit facilities, necessary for income generation.

Ustad Alauddin's death anniversary observed
