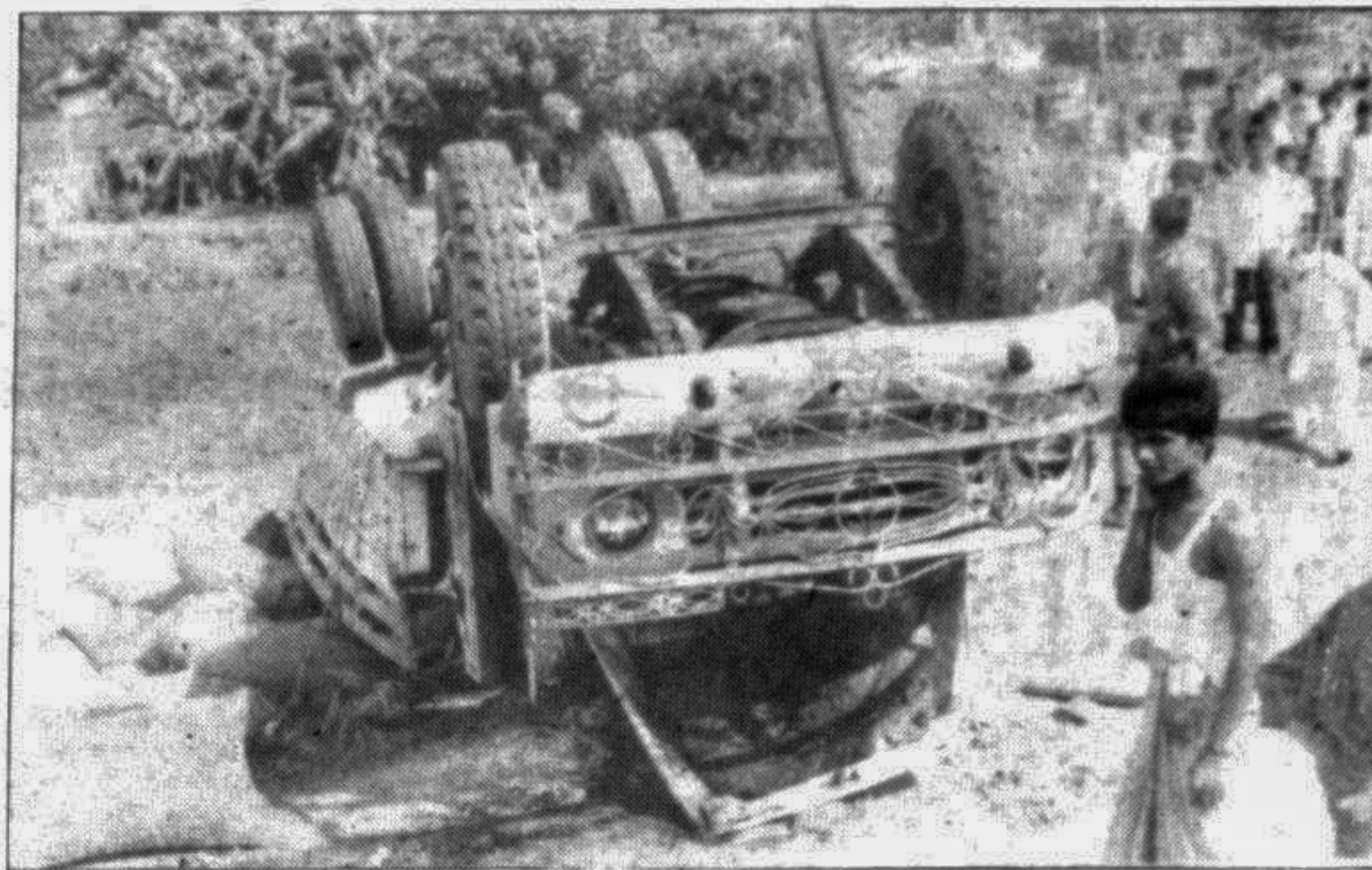

Dhaka products' show begins in Sydney

The second phase of single country exhibition of Bangladesh products began in the Australian city, Sydney on Tuesday to explore market and trade between the two countries, reports UNB.

A press release of Export Promotion Bureau said here yesterday (Wednesday) the exhibition will continue to September 9 which is expected to generate interest among the business community of Australia. Bangladesh sold goods amounted to US dollars 76,000 in the first phase of the trade show held from August 31 to September 2 and sales worth US dollars 5,13,446 was under negotiation as intimated by the coordinator from Melbourne. A total of 134 contacts were also made during the show.

The products displayed during the exhibition included readymade garments, knitwear, ceramic products, frozen food, computer software and handicrafts.

Nazma Jesmin memorial lectures begin Sunday

The fourth 'Nazma Jesmin Chowdhury Memorial Lecture' will begin at the auditorium of the Dhaka University Language Institute on Sunday, reports UNB.

BOU review meet held

A review meeting of the Bangladesh Open University (BOU) was held recently at the temporary office of the university to study the progress of its various programmes. The Vice-Chancellor of BOU Dr M Shamsur Ali presided, says a press release.

The meeting was told that efforts were on to introduce a Secondary School Certificate course from January 1995 for the drop-outs. With the introduction of the course, thousands of unemployed and working people of various age groups particularly women in the villages

Haider made envoy to Cyprus

The government has decided to concurrently accredit Tufail Karim Haider, as ambassador to the Republic of Cyprus with residence in Cairo, a foreign office announcement said yesterday, reports BSS.

DCC may hand over some responsibilities to private sector

Dhaka City Corporation (DCC) Mayor Mirza Abbas yesterday said the corporation was considering handing over some of its responsibilities including clearance of garbage to the private sector in phases, reports BSS.

Addressing a conference of the officers and staff of the DCC at Saidabad in Dhaka Mirza Abbas said this would be done without declaring any employee of the corporation as surplus. He said this would create competition to increase the standard of service where efficiency and experience would be given preference.

He urged the officers and employees of the DCC to protect its assets and goods from wastage and theft and ensure their best utilisation.

Presided over by the president of employees union Amiruzzaman the meeting was addressed by chief engineer of the corporation Qamruzzaman Mahmood, secretary in-charge Salahuddin Mia and general secretary of the union Shamsul Huq Bhuiyan.

One gets 17 yrs RI for keeping arms

A tribunal yesterday sentenced a young man to 17 years rigorous imprisonment for possessing illegal arms, reports UNB.

Tribunal Judge Md Anisuzzaman convicted Kazi Shaifur Rahman alias Munir, 22, of 11, Uttar Bishil, Mirpur, in the city in absentia.

Prosecution case in short is that on March 3, 1991 the accused stopped a rickshaw near Dhanmondi Eidgah field at about 9 pm and tried to kidnap a woman riding the rickshaw.

The woman cried for help, and he was caught by the public and handed over to patrol police. Police searched his body and recovered a pistol with 9 bullets. A case was registered with Dhanmondi police.
