Fish export fetches Tk 700 cr last fiscal

Fisheries and Livestock Minister Abdullah-Al-Noman yesterday said the fisheries sector will be provided with necessary incentives like the industrial sector, reports UNB.

Inaugurating a two-day workshop on 'Improved Management of Openwater Fisheries' here in the morning, he stressed the need for proper management and development of the fisheries sector that makes a significant contribution to the national economy.

The country earned Tk 700 crore by exporting fishes during the last fiscal year, Noman said, adding that the export could be enhanced by providing loans and incentives to the fishermen.

Revenue collection should not be the main objective of fisheries management, it should be aimed at improving socio-economic development of vast

number of people engaged in fishing, he said.

The workshop was jointly organised by Ford Foundation and International Centre for Living Aquatic Resources Management (ICLARM) at Bangladesh Agricultural Research Council (BARC).

State Minister for Land Md Kabir Hossain, Secretary of the Fisheries and Livestock Ministry AZM Nasiruddin and ICLARM coordinator Dr Maahfuzuddin Ahmed also addressed the inaugural function.

The Fisheries and Livestock Minister said a large number of people are dependent on the fishing profession, but they are deprived of fair remuneration being exploited by the middlemen. The government is taking steps to prevent such exploitation by directly dealing with the fishermen, he said.
