Plan to turn Ahsan Manzil into City Museum

The government plans to turn 'Andarmahal', the interior house, of Ahsan Manzil Museum into Dhaka City Museum, authorities said yesterday, reports UNB.

A 'Sight and Sound' system and a projector system will be built there to give a brief history of that time to the spectators so they can have an idea about the lifestyle of the Nawabs.

The National Museum authorities arranged a tour programme for journalists on the first anniversary of Ahsan Manzil Museum to point out the plans and perspective of the Manzil.

Director General of the National Museum Shaikh Akram Ali was with the newsmen during the visit.

The museum earned Tk 9.15 lakh from 457,218 visitors within a year of conversion of the palace of Nawabs to museum, the officials said.

The museum was inaugurated on September 20 last year with 23 galleries open for visitors, including a hospital, billiard room, strongroom, ballroom, dining room and guestrooms.

The father of Nawab Abdul Gani bought the palace from the French and gave it a modern architectural shape with an octavo dome in 1872 and renamed it Ahsan Manzil after his beloved son.

National Museum took a scheme to renovate it in 1986 and completed it last year.

515 Rohingyas back home

Five hundred fifteen Rohingyas refugees voluntarily went back to their homes in Myanmar through two transit camps at Teknaf here Sunday, reports BSS.

Local UNHCR along with Bangladesh officials supervised the repatriation and saw the refugees off at Nayapara-2 and Rongkhali transit camps.

With this 84th batch of repatriation the total number of repatriated persons now stood at 37,162.

Hawkers Parishad demands rapid rehabilitation

Leaders of the Bangladesh Chhinnamul Hawkers Parishad yesterday appealed to the government for their immediate rehabilitation through construction of new hawkers markets for them as they were thrown out of job following the anti-hawkers drive in the city, reports BSS.

"At least five lakh dependent on 80,000 hawkers were now in a precarious condition after the anti-hawkers drive started in Dhaka city," the parishad president Syed Moteab Hossain told a press conference here.

He read out a 12-point charter of demands addressed to the government which included arrangement of alternative jobs, allocation of shops on rent basis only, construction of colony for the hawkers, free education and supply of education materials and uniform for the children of hawkers, free medicare, repeal of all black laws and upholding the spirit of the war of liberation.

The parishad president said they were engaged in hawking business even under severe harassment by the police musclemen only because could find no jobs.
