### One killed, 2 hurt in city

One person was killed and another two were injured in separate incidents in the city Tuesday.

One Mohammed Jahangir Alam, 18, was killed when an auto-tempo overturned in front of the Sena Sardar, Cantonment about 10:30 am.

The victim, Jahangir, who lived near the Air Force Headquarters, was seriously injured and rushed to the Combined Military Hospital (CMH) where the doctors declared him dead.

Police sent the body to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) morgue for autopsy.

A businessman was injured when a group of miscreants stabbed him at the Bangshah crossing in the older part of the city Tuesday morning.

The victim, Mohammed Abdul Halim, 32, alleged that a group of miscreants waylaid him near the Bangshah crossing as he was going to Wiseghat and tried to snatch Tk 10,000 from him.

He resisted and the miscreants stabbed him on his thigh before fleeing.

In another incident, Kalam, 14, was injured when two groups of musclemen clashed at Dolaipar at about noon Tuesday.

Kalam, an employee of one Babul's Garage of Dolaipar, received shrapnel injuries in his face, hands and abdomen when he was crossing the area.

Both the victims were admitted to the DMCH.
