550 power lines disconnected in city

A massive drive against illegal power lines under the guidance of a vigilance team headed by Additional Secretary, Ministry of Energy, Power and Natural Resources, AM Jalaluddin Ahmed was carried out yesterday at New Eskaton, Eskaton, Bailey Road, and Circuit House Road areas under Ramna PS in the city, reports BSS.

In the drive, 550 illegal lines were disconnected, six persons were arrested and 65 cases were instituted against illegal power users.

Connection of illegal line of office of the SDE, PWD Division-IV along with some shops and busees behind the office were snapped the shops were also using illegal power by extended lines from the PWD office.

Smuggled goods worth Tk 1.5 lakh recovered

KHULNA, Sept 25: Bangladesh Navy during routine anti-smuggling and anti-piracy patrols recently recovered smuggled goods worth about Taka one lakh fifty thousand from Mongla Nala and adjoining areas of the Pasur river, an ISPR press release said, reports BSS.

The recovered contrabands included VCP, radio recorder, tyre, loud speaker, table fan, diesel oil, razor blade and steel wires of different sizes.

One beaten to death

A mob beat one terrorist to death at Shampur, Palpara under Demra police station in the city at noon Friday.

A group of local men dragged Mohammed Salim, the victim, from Munshikhola to Shampur and beat him up severely.

Police, acting on a tip rushed to the scene and rescued the victim in a critical condition and sent him to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) where he succumbed to his injuries early Saturday.

Police said Salim was wanted for various charges.

A case was filed with Demra police station. None has been arrested till writing the report.

Police sent the body to the DMCH morgue for autopsy.

Clarification

New low-cost fertiliser

A Bangladeshi researcher yesterday claimed to have invented a new type of low-cost, low-chemical fertiliser which, he said, will boost crop production in the country, reports UNB.

Dr A Khaleque, a research scholar in the University of London, said his newly-invented "Phytohormone Inducer" can be applied successfully to increase the biological quantities of the crop producing soil.

The cost for the new fertiliser will be only about Tk 60 per bigha compared to Tk 470 for the high-chemical fertilisers now being used in the country, he told newsmen at a briefing at the Jatiya Press Club in the afternoon.

Quoting available data, Dr Khaleque said the country has some 33 million acres of cultivable land and it should produce at least 66 million tons of foodgrain taking the current world average of two ton per acre. But annual production of foodgrain in Bangladesh is only a meagre 19-20 million tons, he added.

Dr Khaleque said the country's crop production could be increased by using his new fertiliser which, he claimed, will also maintain the balance of physical biological characteristics of the soil and reduce pollution to the water resources.

Giving details about "Phytohormone Inducer" for which applications have been filed for Bangladesh and Commonwealth patents, Dr Khaleque said it's a formulation to induce phytohormone from its natural precursors skeletons and indols and their derivatives.

"Such skeletons and indols and

the derivatives are available naturally from biological and microbial decay present in the fertile and crop producing land."

He said the presented phytohormone-inducing formulation is being fortified with essential dressers elements (micro-nutrients) according to the soil type of Bangladesh.

"The formulation (phytohormone inducer) along with trassers elements are composed of oxides of metallic and non-metal elements in general, and are natural components of the fertile soil and has no evidence of biological hazards whatsoever so far."

Dr Khaleque informed that he began working with the idea five years ago. Field trial on the formulation was carried out in the country while the scientific analyses were carried out at biological laboratories at the University of London, he added.

She inquired about the condition of Hashem Khan and asked the attending physicians to ensure his proper treatment. She also prayed for speedy recovery of the artist.

Cultural Secretary Islam Uddin Malik and Director General of Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy Mobarak Hossain Khan accompanied the state minister.

Protesting the killing of its leader Abul Khair at Hathazari in Chittagong on September 23, the BCL also demanded ban on the politics of Jammal-Shibir.

Abul Khair, an activist of BCL (M-I), Hathazari Unit, was shot allegedly by some Shibir activists on September 22 and he died on September 23.

The BCL in a rally held at the Aparajeo Bangla of the Dhaka University yesterday morning also warned the government of a greater student agitation if the ruling party continued their alleged support to protect Jammal-Shibir clique.

The rally was addressed, among others, by the BCL leaders Iqbalur Rahim, Pankaj Nath, Iqbal Hossain Apu, Enamul Huq Shamim with its DU unit President KHM Liza in the chair.

Earlier the leaders and workers of the BCL (M-I) brought out a procession on the university campus.
