

ISLAMABAD, Oct 11: Benazir Bhutto and her rival expremier Nawaz Sharif accused each other today of buying deputies in their tussle to form a coalition government in Pakistan's hung parliament, reports Reuter.

"I think we have the centre sewn up' said a spokesman for Bhutto, whose Pakistan People's Party (PPP) victory in two of four crucial provincial elections on Saturday virtually assured her of the regional support she needs to recapture the post of Prime Minister.

However, as the two leaders held frenetic meeting with potential allies. Bhutto raised lears Sharif was using the wealth of his family's industrial conglomerate to buy over independent deputies.

Whip Tara, 9 others hurt in bomb attack

FENI, Oct 11: Whip Mahbubul Alam Tara and nine others accompanying him, including three cops, were injured in an armed attack by opponents here today, officials said, reports

RABIUS SANI 25, 1414 HIJRI

The district administration imposed Section 144 on the municipal area for an indefinite period to avert further violence as tension mounted in the town after the incident.

Officials and ruling BNP leaders blamed the Awami League supporters for the attack at 12 noon. Several bombs were hurled at the Whip's car. they said.

Of the injured, two policemen - Nurul Islam and Jainul Abedin - were admitted to the Sadar Hospital while president of BNP Sadar thana unit Shameul Hag was rushed to a local clinic with serious splinter infuries.

Tara was injured slightly. APS to the Whip, Fazlul Karim Bablu, got a splinter in his right

According to the sources, the Awami League and the Chhatra League activists came in a procession and attacked Tara's car on way to his village home at Farhadnagar in Sadar thana from the Circuit House. The vehicle was damaged.

The Awami Leaguers were protesting the installation of an additional polling centre in ward number 6 for the forthcoming Pourasava election scheduled for October 17.

District BNP activists brought out a procession in the town protesting the attack on the Whip

Tara told the Deputy Commissioner that there was no need of Section 144 and that the restrictions might hamper campaign for the forthcoming pourasava election.

BNP district committee president Advocate Abul Hashem and general secretary Shahiduddin Ferdous also spoke against the imposition of Section 144.

BADC will be reorganised: Polythene bags banned

The cabinet yesterday approved an Agriculture Ministry proposal for reorganising the Bangladesh Agricultural Development Corporation (BADC) squeezing its functions, reports

It also approved a proposal of the Ministry of Environment and Forest restricting the manufacture of plastic or polythene shopping bags in the country

The existing industries producing plastic or polythene bags will have to stop production of shopping bags for local use within three months, an official handout said.

The approval came in the regular weekly meeting of the cabinet held at Bangabhaban with Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia in the chair

As per the proposed reorganisation, based on the recom mendations of the Dr Igbal Mahmood Committee, BADC's corporate status will be retained, but its scale of operations will be limited to certain core functions to meet some of the strategic agricultural development needs.

All sectors but jute show export growth

Export earnings during the first two months of fiscal 1993-94 increased by about 10.98 per cent over the corresponding period last year.

During the time the country has been able to come out of its 'mono product' based export thrust and all sectors excepting jute and jute goods showed export growth.

The export performance during the period was also helped by a 2.24 per cent increase in the export price index.

During July-August, 1993-94 fiscal, the country's exports stood at 459.04 million US dollars against the annual target of 2900 million dollars.

The volume of export also increased by 8.74 per cent during the period compared to last

year's corresponding period. In the frozen food sector, the country earned 42.19 million dollars against 39.42 million of last year's corresponding period. The amount was 44.63 per cent higher than the target for the sector.

Tea exports fetched 7.13 million dollars against last year's 4.08 million dollars for the same period. This year's two month's earnings were 8.36 per cent higher than the target.
