

Country is turned into market for Indian goods: AL

Awami League general secretary Zillur Rahman Thursday accused the government of turning the country into a market for Indian goods, reports UNB.

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia has sold out the interest of countrymen to India by "signing an 11-point treaty of submission" recently, he alleged while addressing a Chhatra League rally at Badda. Zillur further blamed the government for "creating confusion among the people through false statements" instead of taking any step to serve their interest.

"It has lost moral right to stay in power," he said charging the government with misrule.

The Awami League leader said the government of Begum Zia within a short time of its rule surpassed all records of misdeed of the previous autocratic regime.

Continuing his tirade, Zillur Rahman also blamed the government for widespread terrorism and corruption and called upon the people to unite to free themselves from the "misrule" of BNP.

The rally was presided over by Md Farook Milon and also addressed by among others, by Advocate Sahara Khatun, Alamgir Kumum, Abbas Ullah, AKM Latmuzzaman, Osman Gani and Farook Mehd.
