Progress in livestock development is not adequate: Noman

Minister for Fisheries and Livestock Abdullah Al-Noman said yesterday that a successful cattle farmer could never be in a state of poverty and that was why the present government laid emphasis on wide-spread cattle farming in the country for successful implementation of the poverty alleviation programmes, reports BSS.

Noman was addressing as the chief guest the inaugural function of the two-day Dhaka Divisional Workshop on 'Livestock Development' at the Bangladesh Agricultural Research Council (BARC) auditorium.

The minister said that significant progress had been achieved in livestock development but it was not adequate to meet the demand of the country. He said that in order to accelerate this speed of development, the concerned officers have to be committed to reach different facilities to the people.

In this connection, Noman referred to the success achieved in crop production and said that the success in crop sector would have no lasting impact without the development of livestock and fisheries as sub-sectors of agriculture.

Noman said that this workshop would help to identify the problems from free discussion of the field-level officers. He said that the local officers could play important role to encourage the people engaged in cattle farming to voluntarily serve as extension workers locally.

Presided over by the Director of Livestock Dr Nazir Ahmed, the function was addressed, among others, by the Secretary, Ministry of Fisheries and Livestock A Z M Nasiruddin, Executive Vice Chairman of BARC Dr M. Sajaatullah and Additional Director of Livestock Dr Zia-Uddin Ahmed.
