### Discussion meet on Khaled Mosharraf held

Begum Sufia Kamal Sunday afternoon called upon the people to demand trial of the killers of Brigadier Khaled Mosharraf. Bir Uttam, who died in a sepoy mutiny four days after he himself had led a coup d'etat on November 3, 1975.

Sufia Kamal was addressing as chief guest, a discussion meeting commemorating the deaths of Khaled Mosharraf and two of his military associates. Organised by the Khaled Mosharraf Smriti Sangsad, the meeting was addressed, among others, by Major (Retd) Rafiqul Islam, Bir Uttam, Colonel (Retd) Shawkat Ali, MP, MR Akhter Mukul, Major (Retd) Akhter Ahmed, Bir Protick, Rashed Mosharraf, MP, and Khaled's widow Begum Salma Khaled.

Dr. Anisuzzaman of the Dhaka university, who attended the meeting as a guest speaker but left the audience, without addressing, a few minutes before the discussion was concluded.

The speakers observed that Khaled was a true patriot and had served the nation to the best of his abilities during the country's War of Independence in 1971. Khaled was a sector commander during the country's Liberation War.

The speakers also observed that those who had come to the power through felling Khaled's, as they put it, "military action" on November 3, deliberately launched a propaganda that Khaled was an Indian agent. Colonel (Retd) Shawkat Ali, MP, of the Awami League (AL) claimed that the baseless propaganda was necessary for the leaders of the November 7 coup to justify their misdeeds. The AL MP accused the BNP of distorting history.

Explaining the reasons for the November 3 military action led by Khaled Mosharraf, Ali said, Khaled could not accept the killing of the then president Sheikh Mujibur Rahman and as a result he wanted to overthrow the unconstitutional government headed by Khandaker Mushtaque Ahmed. The second objective behind Khaled's attempt (coup) was to restore the chain of command in the army. Shawkat said, adding that after the killing of Mujib on August 15, a number of low-ranking army officers were governing the country from the Bangladeshabad.

Humayun Kabir, who claimed himself to be one of Khaled's close associates in the November 3 coup endorsed the views put forward by Col Shawkat and observed that the attempt was in a way successful because the Mushtaque regime had been overthrown.

Rafiqul Islam, another sector commander of the Liberation War and an advisor to interim President Justice Shahabuddin in 1991, felt that Khaled Mosharraf was killed in the backdrop of national and international conspiracies hatched to frustrate the people's victory in 1971. Khaled is yet to get his due honour, Rafiq maintained.

Referring to the much-talked about issue of 'distortion of history', Rafiq said, "Unfortunately the people who fought for the country's liberation were today divided into different camps and were distorting the history for vested interests."

M R Akhter Mukul, while recollecting a meeting of the sector commanders and political leadership during the Liberation War, said "Some of the military leaders wanted to form a war council parallel to the Mujib-nagar Government. But Khaled Mosharraf opposed the idea with a view to avoiding any possible conflict between the politicians and military officials."

Rashed Mosharraf, MP, and Begum Salma Khaled, maintained that Khaled was not one to sacrifice the national interest to benefit a foreign country.

Held at the Bangladesh Chemical Industries Corporation (BCIC) auditorium, the discussion was presided over by Humayun Kabir. It was conducted by drama artiste Peejush Banerjee.

### Dhaka City Family Planning Campaign launched

The government and non-government organisations (NGOs) launched yesterday a combined campaign for motivating increased numbers of able couples to adopt family planning methods to contain population rise in the metropolis of 7 million, reports UNB.

A colourful rally, led by Mayor Mirza Abbas, MP, paraded the city streets, marking the start of the "Dhaka City Family Planning Campaign and Service Week" with special emphasis to reach family planning methods to the slum-dwellers.

Nearly 1,000 family planning workers from the government and non-government organisations are motivating people through rallies, discussion meetings, film and cultural shows to accept birth-control methods.

Director General of Family Planning AKM Rafiqul-Zaman told a press conference on the occasion that the week-long drive intended to raise the number of eligible couples under family planning methods from 50 to 70 per cent.

There are 10 lakh capable couples in the capital inhabited by an estimated 70 lakh people, and several hundred field workers of the government and NGOs in 100 clinics are working for family planning in the metropolis which is going to be a mega-city in the year 2000.

Stressing concerted efforts both by the government and NGOs to make family planning programme a success, the DG said family planning activists and 532 registered NGOs were working in 1067 areas throughout the country.

"Success of family planning programme depends on education," he said, adding only 7 per cent eligible couples were following traditional family planning method which is much higher in Sri Lanka.

The government is actively considering establishing condom and Inter Uterine Device (IUD) manufacturing plants in the country, he told newsmen.

"We should be independent in producing contraceptive materials,"

Replying to a question, Rafiqul-Zaman said "we follow cafeteria approach of family planning and anyone can choose, any method." On Menstruation Regulation, he said MR is legal within six weeks of pregnancy.

Family Planning Association of Bangladesh, a member of the London-based International Plant Parenthood Federation, organised the press conference which was also addressed, among others, by honorary Secretary General of FPAB Kazi Anisur Rahman, honorary Secretary of FPAB Humayun Kabir Khandker, AU Rashid Ahmed Khan and Mizanur Rahman.

Kazi Anis said about 50 NGOs were now active in the field of family planning.

He said family planning means to make people aware about the bad aspects of repeated pregnancy and early pregnancy. Family planning is a package service, not only supply of birth-control devices. It also takes care of mother and child health, he added.

The Nov 8-14 programme includes rallies, film shows, discussions, motivational programmes, essay competition, cultural shows and Vitamin 'A' Capsul distribution among pregnant mothers.

### BCS General Edn Assoc main demands accepted

The government has accepted the main demands of the BCS General Education Association following a fruitful discussion yesterday, reports UNB.

The Association leaders met the Education Minister Jamiruddin Sircar and discussed their 16-point demand.

The meeting reached a consensus on creation of 450 posts in government colleges, fill up about 1400 vacant posts of the lecturers through special BCS and opportunities for higher education and scholarships to government college teachers.

It was also decided in the meeting that selection grade will be given soon to the associate professors and promotion cases at all levels will be taken up immediately.

The Minister stressed the need for improving the standard of college education and making it relevant to the needs of the time.

Education Secretary Ershadul Haq, Director General Secondary and Higher Education Prof M Yunus Mia, Association leaders Dr QATM Habibur Rahman, Prof Abu Yusuf and Enayet Hossain Mia were present in the meeting.

### Fast-food outlet gutted in city

A fast-food outlet at Gulshan was burned down in a fire incident on Saturday last.

The fire at the 'Hot Hut', located at Gulshan (North) opposite to Video Connection, started late in the evening on the day and quickly engulfed the establishment.

Later, a Fire Service squad from the Tejgaon station arrived on the spot and doused the fire promptly.

According to the Fire Department, the fire started shortly before 11 pm while the Fire Service personnel reached the spot at 11:05 pm and brought it under control.

However, the Fire Department said that the cause of the fire is yet to be ascertained.

A General Diary (GD) was also recorded with the Gulshan Police Station.

Tanvir Mirza, the co-owner of the establishment, said that all furniture, equipment and fittings inside the outlet were completely destroyed in the fire.

The fast-food outlet has been operating at the location for nearly the past five years.
