

# 2 killed, 12 hurt in separate incidents

At least two persons were killed and a dozen others injured in separate incidents in the Dhaka metropolitan area Tuesday.

A 32-year-old woman, Bedana Khatun, was electrocuted at her Gobindapur, Demra, residence when she came in contact with a live electric wire in her home at around noon.

A garments factory employee Shameem, 25, reportedly committed suicide by hanging himself in his room at Taraidar Lane, Hazaribagh, in the morning.

Police recovered the body and sent it to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) morgue. The cause of the suicide was not immediately known.

At least a dozen people were injured, one of them seriously, when two groups of hoodlums clashed at a slum in Agargaon Monday night and Tuesday afternoon.

Of the injured, Abdur Rashid, 22, was admitted to the DMCH with severe shrapnel injuries while one Lokman Hossain was given first aid at the same hospital.

The clashing groups exploded scores of crackers and cocktails and fired gunshots while chasing each other.

Witnesses said the clash was an outcome of a long-running feud among the rival groups over asserting their domination in the slum.
