Private clinic docs sued for neglect

A relative of a 32-year-old woman who died at a private clinic Sunday has lodged a case against the attending doctors of the clinic.

Lababul Haque Dulal, in an unnatural death (UD) case filed with the Motijheel police Sunday, alleged that his niece Zebunnessa Zebu had died following negligence of the attending doctors, the duty officer of the Motijheel Police Station said.

Zebunnessa, wife of one N M Alamgir, was admitted to the Farida Clinic at Shantinagar on Tuesday last and died there Sunday morning. She was in her ninth month of pregnancy.

However, Dr T A Chowdhury, owner of the clinic, told the Daily Star that Zebunnessa had died of cardiac arrest.

Namaz-e-janaza
The namaz-e-janaza of Mazharuddin Ahmed will be held at the Jame Mosque near the Tongi Diversion Road rail crossing (Dilu Road) after Esha prayers today, says a press release.

Ahmed, 64, son of late Washimuddin Ahmad, died of heart ailment on November 5 in Los Angeles, US.
